Heavy vehicle movements for rail construction

Inland Rail is a once-in-a-generation project connecting regional Australia to domestic and international markets. Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) has engaged INLink (a joint venture between BMD Constructions and Fulton Hogan) to build the first section of Inland Rail, from Parkes to Narromine.

From Parkes to Narromine

From Thursday 18 April 2019 we will start building the rail formation (the supportive foundations of the track) made from soil and rock on the new North West Link rail corridor in Parkes. Between 20 to 50 trucks per day will be moving material from the quarry to our sites on Brolgan and Coopers Roads, travelling on the below heavy vehicle routes.

Heavy vehicle routes - from Thursday 18 April 2019 until the end of July 2019

To minimise impacts to local roads we will use National and State roads wherever possible. We will be using Bogan Road, Newell Highway, Hartigan Avenue, Brolgan Road, and Coopers Road.
