



## CHAIR'S SUMMARY

The sixth meeting of the Scenic Rim Community Consultative Committee (the committee) was held in Beaudesert on Thursday, 21 February 2019.

The Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting and ensures that information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting record, the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Ms Kathy Baburin and attended by seven of the 13 local community representatives, appointed as members of the committee.

A total of 16 observers attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide a project update, showing the Calvert to Kagaru current Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) design and feasibility alignment.

Presentations were provided by the ARTC Calvert to Kagaru (C2K) project team.

Information provided to the committee included:

- ▶ An update on the feasibility of the proposed rail alignment design to date.
- ▶ The project team are progressing field work and working towards confirming the alignment from Calvert to Kagaru.
- ▶ Councils, landowners and government agencies are being met with to discuss proposed road rail interfaces.
- ▶ Crossing loops: Ebenezer loop has been moved 3.3km East, Purga Creek loop has been moved 3km East, Washpool loop has been moved 400m West and Undullah loop remains unchanged.
- ▶ Flood modelling process currently underway and results will be shared with the community in the coming months.

- ▶ Environmental studies are continuing and ARTC anticipates submitting the EIS to the Coordinator-General in mid-2019.
- ▶ Flora and fauna methodology workshops will be held next week with environment groups to explain methodology.
- ▶ The ARTC Inland Rail Social Performance team have partnered with Primary Health Care Network for community members seeking mental health support. People can call the assistance line on **1300 971 309**.

Committee members raised the following actions during the meeting:

- ▶ Inland Rail to meet with Ivory Rock representatives to share and discuss noise results.
- ▶ Inland Rail to send a schedule of business chamber meetings to the committee.
- ▶ Inland Rail to share a list of attendees that participated in the flood modelling workshops.
- ▶ Inland Rail to send the flora and fauna methodology workshop invitation list to the committee and members to provide details of any additional groups that should also be invited to attend.
- ▶ C2K project team to provide committee with bullet points summarising workshops or group consultation sessions after they occur.
- ▶ Inland Rail to present on noise goals and job opportunities at the next meeting in May.

The next Scenic Rim Community Consultative Committee meeting will be held in Peak Crossing on Thursday 23 May 2019 from 6–8pm. Location of the venue will be updated closer to the time.

Details of the next meeting will be advertised on the ARTC website, to ensure those who would like to attend have that opportunity.
