HERITAGE CONSIDERATIONS IN GLENROWAN

ARTC's Inland Rail project in Victoria now has a reference design for the proposed Beaconsfield Parade bridge in Glenrowan. This bridge needs modifications to provide the clearances to enable the safe passage of double-stacked freight trains.

This overview map shows views of the reference design for the proposed Beaconsfield Parade bridge from particular locations and directions that Heritage Victoria require to review in considering the heritage permit application for this site.

The views* are for reference only and are subject to change. They indicate what an open-span bridge for Beaconsfield Parade in Glenrowan might look like in relation to the existing heritage values.

The map and views are included in the Inland Rail project Tottenham to Albury (Stage 1 – Beveridge to Albury) heritage permit application for the Glenrowan Heritage Precinct (H2000).

The views consider the following elements:

- ▶ What an open-span bridge may look like within the town
- ▶ Avoid impacts to heritage listed features
- ▶ Visual connectivity through the heritage precinct
- ▶ Maintaining access for pedestrians, cyclists, drivers, and other users of the new bridge
- ▶ Facilitates views of the heritage precinct
- ▶ Connectivity between the replica Station and the Station Master's House archaeological site.
