Chair's summary

The sixteenth meeting of the Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee (CCC) was held online for COVID-safe reasons on **Thursday, 17 February 2022**.

This Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting regarding the ARTC Inland Rail Calvert to Kagaru (C2K) Project. This summary is a precursor to the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Ms Kathy Baburin, and attended by nine representatives appointed as members of the committee. Two apologies were received by committee members. A total of 37 observers attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide information on ARTC Inland Rail's operational modelling regarding the anticipated future train numbers and timings and discuss some upcoming community engagement activities to inform the next round of the draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

An update was provided from the Chair of the International Flood Panel and from the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications on intermodal terminals.
