

Chair's summary

Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee

The eighteenth meeting of the Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee (CCC) was held both in person at the Ipswich Civic Centre and online on Thursday, 4 August 2022.

This Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting regarding the ARTC Inland Rail Calvert to Kagaru (C2K) Project. This summary is a precursor to the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Ms Kathy Baburin, and attended by six representatives appointed as members of the committee (four in person and two online). Five apologies were received by committee members. Five observers attended the meeting and two observers attended online, totalling seven observers.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide information on the land acquisition process, including severance and rationalisation, and a Social Performance Community Wellbeing activity.
