

Chair's summary

Inland Rail Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee

The twenty first meeting of the Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee (CCC) was held on **Thursday 9 March 2023** at 1 Union Place, Ipswich and online via Microsoft Teams.

This Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting and is a precursor to the committee meeting minutes, to be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

Half of the meeting was chaired by Ms Kathy Baburin with Ms Angela Collyer chairing the remainder of meeting. The meeting was attended by seven representatives appointed as members of the committee, with an additional member joining online. Two apologies were received by committee members. Eight observers attended the meeting in person and three observers attended the meeting online.
