

Traffic changes and bridge works

Hamilton Street bridge, Broadford

1 to 30 June 2025 (with night works)

John Holland will commence construction of a new Shared Use Path (SUP) bridge at Hamilton Street in June. These works will require long-term temporary traffic changes.

Work being done

- Construction of a new Shared Use Path bridge starting with foundation and abutment works
- Establishment of long-term temporary traffic changes and a pedestrian detour
- Site establishment at 62 High Street and 51 Ferguson Street, including installation of fencing and worker facilities
- Utility relocation on Hamilton Street during round-the-clock works, 2-6 June
- Service investigations, surveys and vegetation removal as required at various locations.

What can I expect?

- **Construction works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- **Round-the-clock works, 7am Monday 2 June to 6pm Friday 6 June**
- **Extended work hours, 4.30am-7.30pm, Monday 16 and Monday 30 June**
- Long-term temporary traffic changes will be in place during construction. *See attached map for traffic and management and changes to bridge access*
- Single lane shuttle-flow over Hamilton Street bridge
- Road closures on Ferguson Street, Dairy Lane and between High Street and High Street service road
- Short-term road closure on Hamilton Street, near the intersection of Ferguson Street, for one

week. A small detour will be in place via Hawdon, Pinniger and Ferguson streets

- Temporary roundabout at the intersection of Hamilton and Hawdon streets
- Traffic management, reduced speeds and vehicle and pedestrian detours
- Residents impacted by out-of-hours work will be contacted prior
- Residents impacted by interruptions to property services from utility relocation works will be notified by the service provider
- Nearby residents may notice some vibration during works to compact the ground.

Machinery used

Non-destructive digging truck, excavators, tipper trucks, cranes, piling rigs, support vehicles, compaction rollers, loaders, graders, concrete trucks, workers using hand tools and survey equipment, traffic management equipment and signage.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place for noise, dust and vibration
- An arborist and qualified wildlife handler will assess all trees before removal.

Cancellation of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled at short notice depending on weather and other factors. Should this occur, works will be rescheduled.

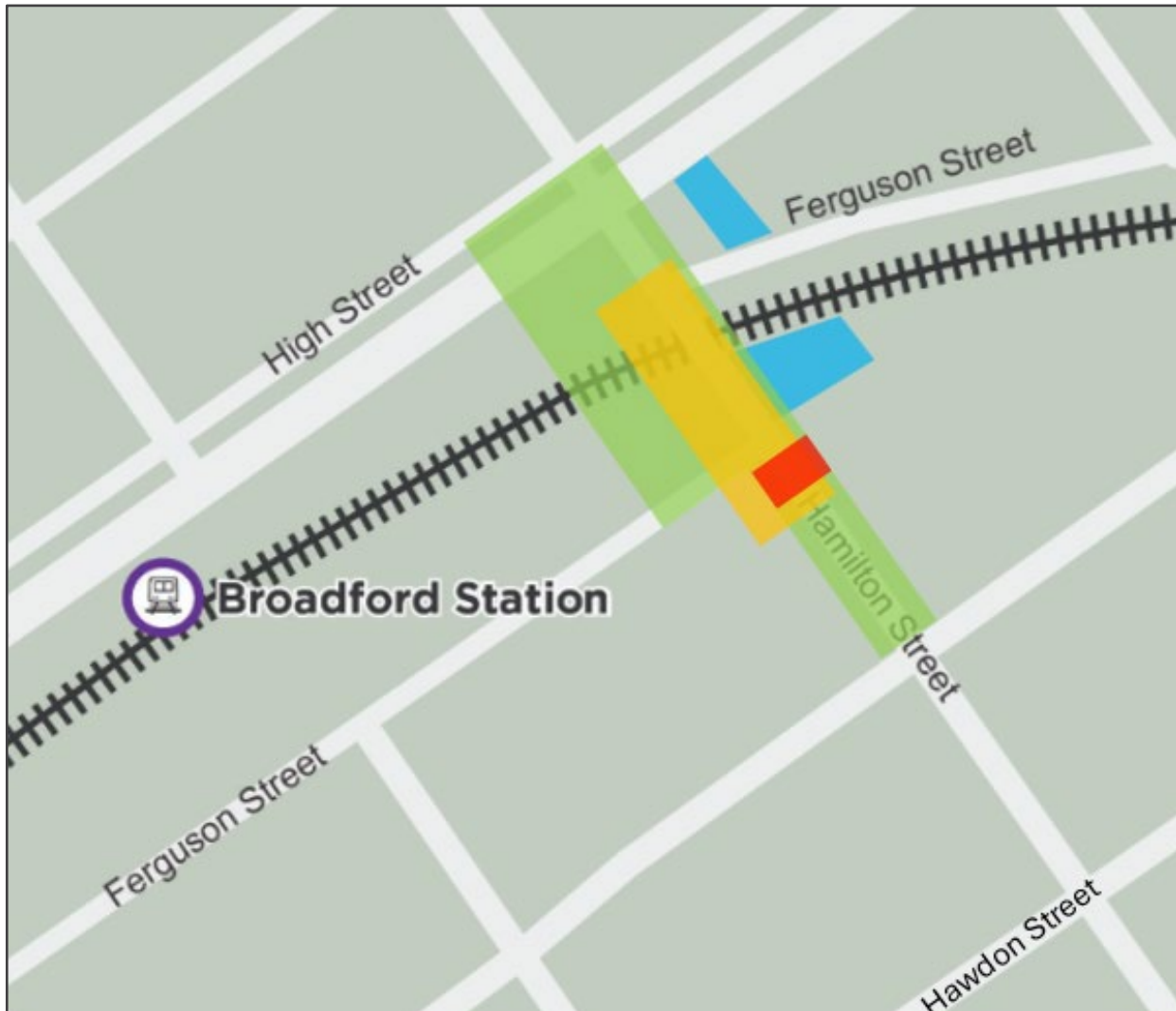


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Legend

Inland Rail works in Broadford

At times, Inland Rail works will occur at other locations in Broadford. Scan the QR code for works notifications detailing construction activities taking place in other areas.



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What's happening at the Hamilton Street bridge?

To increase the clearance under the Hamilton Street bridge we're replacing the bridge with a new higher structure and lowering the rail tracks to support double-stacked freight trains. From May there will be changes to traffic conditions around the worksite, as we construct the new bridge.

Road and pedestrian changes

1

To access the area needed to construct the new bridge, one lane will be closed on Hamilton Street bridge. Single lane shuttle flow and temporary traffic lights combined with traffic management will be in place.

2

To support traffic flow a temporary roundabout will be installed at the Hamilton and Hawdon streets intersection, with left turn only access from Ferguson Street (north) onto Hamilton Street.

3

To access the area needed to upgrade the road, a small section of Ferguson Street (south) will be closed.

4

To reduce congestion along High Street, vehicle traffic will be closed at the High and Hamilton streets intersection.

- From High Street over the bridge will be via left turn from the High Street service lane
- From Hamilton Street bridge to High Street will be left turn only via High Street service lane adjacent to carwash.

To keep pedestrians safe during bridge works and while a new shared use path is constructed, a detour will be available via the Broadford train station.
