

Traffic changes and bridge works

Short Street bridge, Broadford

1 to 30 June 2025

John Holland will commence construction of the new Short Street bridge in June. These works will require long-term temporary traffic changes with detours in place.

Work being done

- Construction starting on the new Short Street bridge with foundation and abutment works both sides of the rail line
- Establishment of piling pads near each bridge abutment
- Establishment of long-term temporary traffic changes including vehicle and pedestrian detours
- Works to temporarily reinstate access between Burges Lane and Cameron Parade
- Installation of temporary footpaths
- Relocation of utility services
- Services and ground investigations
- Approved tree removal as required at various locations.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- **Extended work hours, 4.30am-7.30pm, Monday 16 and Monday 30 June.** Impacted residents will be contacted prior
- Long-term traffic changes will be in place during construction. *See attached map for traffic and pedestrian changes*
- Single-lane shuttle flow across Short Street bridge will start in June
- Road closures to Short Street at Rupert Street (north) with access via Lorine Parade, and

Sutherland Street with access via Jamieson Street

- As the works progress, road closure to Short Street at Rupert Street (south) with access via a detour on Mia Mia Road, Cameron Parade and Burges Lane. Access between Burges Lane and Cameron Parade will be temporarily reinstated to facilitate this detour
- Pedestrian access maintained across Short Street bridge
- Residents impacted by interruptions to services from utility relocation works will be notified by the service provider
- Nearby residents may notice some vibration during works to compact the ground.

Machinery used

Non-destructive digging truck, directional drill, ground drill, excavators, tipper trucks, cranes, piling rigs, support vehicles, compaction rollers, loaders, graders, concrete trucks, water carts, workers using hand tools and survey equipment, traffic management equipment, generators and signage.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place for noise, dust and vibration
- An arborist and qualified wildlife handler will assess all trees before removal.

Cancellation of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled at short notice depending on weather and other factors. Should this occur, works will be rescheduled.

What's happening at the Short Street bridge?

We're replacing Short Street bridge with a new higher structure and lowering the rail tracks to increase clearance under the bridge to support double-stacked freight trains. From June there will be changes to traffic conditions around the worksite, as we construct the new bridge.



Traffic changes

1

To access the area needed to construct the new bridge, one lane will be closed on the Short Street bridge. Single lane shuttle flow and temporary traffic lights combined with traffic management will be in place.

2

To support traffic flow and reduce congestion, a road closure will be in place at Sutherland Street with a detour via Jamieson and High streets.

3

A road closure to support traffic flow will be in place at Rupert Street (eastern side) with a detour via Lorine Parade.

4

A road closure to support traffic flow will be in place at Rupert Street (western side) with a detour via Burges Lane, Cameron Parade and Mia Mia Road.

5

Works to upgrade the detour route will take place at the intersection of Burges Lane and Cameron Parade.

Road closures and detours will be implemented in a staged approach as works progress. Please follow signage and drive safely during this time.
