

Powerline works Avenel Railway Station 26 May to 30 May



McConnell Dowell has been engaged to undertake construction on the Inland Rail project in Victoria.

Work being done

To enable the safe running of double-stacked freight trains additional height clearance between the rail and powerlines is required in some locations along the North East rail line including at Avenel Railway Station.

To achieve this, McConnell Dowell will be removing power cables, installing new poles and running new cables at locations in and around Avenel train station.

What can I expect?

- **Works between 7am–7pm Monday to Friday**
- Delivery of materials and equipment
- Construction noise during the works
- Plant and other vehicles entering and exiting the works area
- Machinery and equipment operating onsite, including a scissor lift on the station platform
- Delivery of materials and equipment
- Traffic management for vehicles, pedestrians and rail passengers.

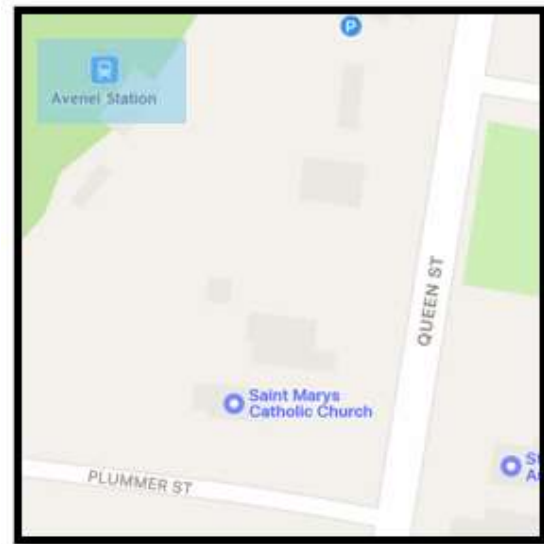
Machinery used

- Elevated work platforms, cranes, light towers and light vehicles will be used within the work area.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management on local roads to support plant and other vehicles entering and exiting the works area
- Traffic management, where required to assist pedestrians at the Avenel Railway Station
