McConnell Dowell has been engaged to undertake construction on the Inland Rail project in Victoria.

Work being done

To enable the safe running of double-stacked freight trains additional height clearance between the rail and powerlines is required in some locations along the North East line including at the Chiltern Railway Station.

To achieve this, McConnell Dowell will be removing some power cables, installing new poles and cables and completing electrical work inside the station building.

What can I expect?

- Works between 7am-7pm, Monday to Friday
- Delivery of materials and equipment
- Access to the works area via Wills Street and Railway Access Road
- Traffic management to support plant and other vehicles entering and exiting the works area, may cause minor traffic delays
- Machinery and equipment operating onsite
- Construction noise during the day.

Machinery used


 Elevated work platforms, non-destructive digging truck, cranes and light vehicles will be used within the work area.
