

Geotechnical, Survey Investigation and Vegetation Trimming – Wagga Wagga June – August 2025

Martinus has been engaged to undertake construction on the Albury to Illabo section of the Inland Rail project in New South Wales.

Martinus will undertake various investigation and vegetation trimming work within the railway corridor and adjacent road surfaces in Wagga Wagga from **June to August 2025**, weather and ground conditions permitting.

The work will occur during normal construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 6pm on Saturday**.

In the event that work is required outside these construction hours, impacted neighbours will be notified in advance.

Work being done

- geotechnical and service investigations, including non-destructive digging (NDD)
- environmental surveys and monitoring
- cadastral survey
- minor signalling work
- minor approved vegetation trimming around the Cassidy Footbridge. Additional approved tree and vegetation removal may be undertaken in the future as required for the permanent replacement of the footbridge.

What can I expect?

- traffic management may be required in some locations where works are occurring close to roads or for safe access. Please observe all traffic management instructions and signage
- survey and testing equipment will be operating on-site during the hours noted above

- increased vehicle movements with site vehicles and support vehicles accessing work sites
- nearby residents may experience some daytime noise

Machinery used

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to excavators, drill rigs, small truck mounted drill rig, NDD truck, grass cutter, water carts and support vehicles, workers using hand tools and survey equipment, traffic management equipment and signage.

How we're managing impacts


- An arborist will assess all trees
- All areas will be inspected by a qualified wildlife handler for wildlife before tree removal works commence. If fauna is encountered, works will cease until the wildlife handler has safely relocated the animal
- Use of non-tonal reversing alarms on all equipment and turning off equipment when not in use
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours
- Works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Approval Conditions.

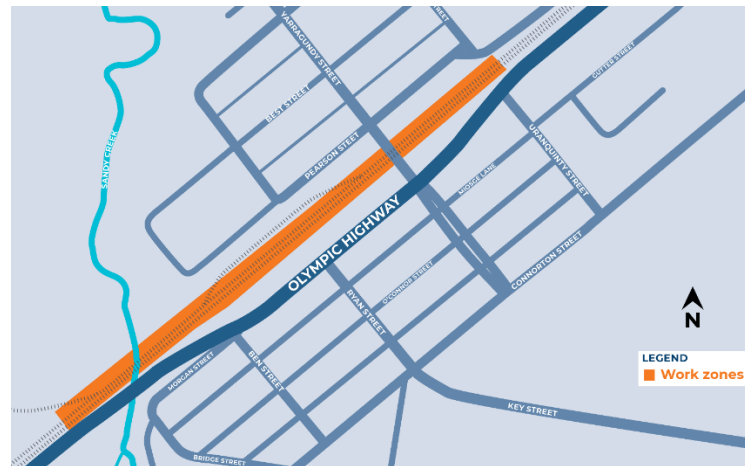
1. Cassidy Parade Pedestrian Bridge

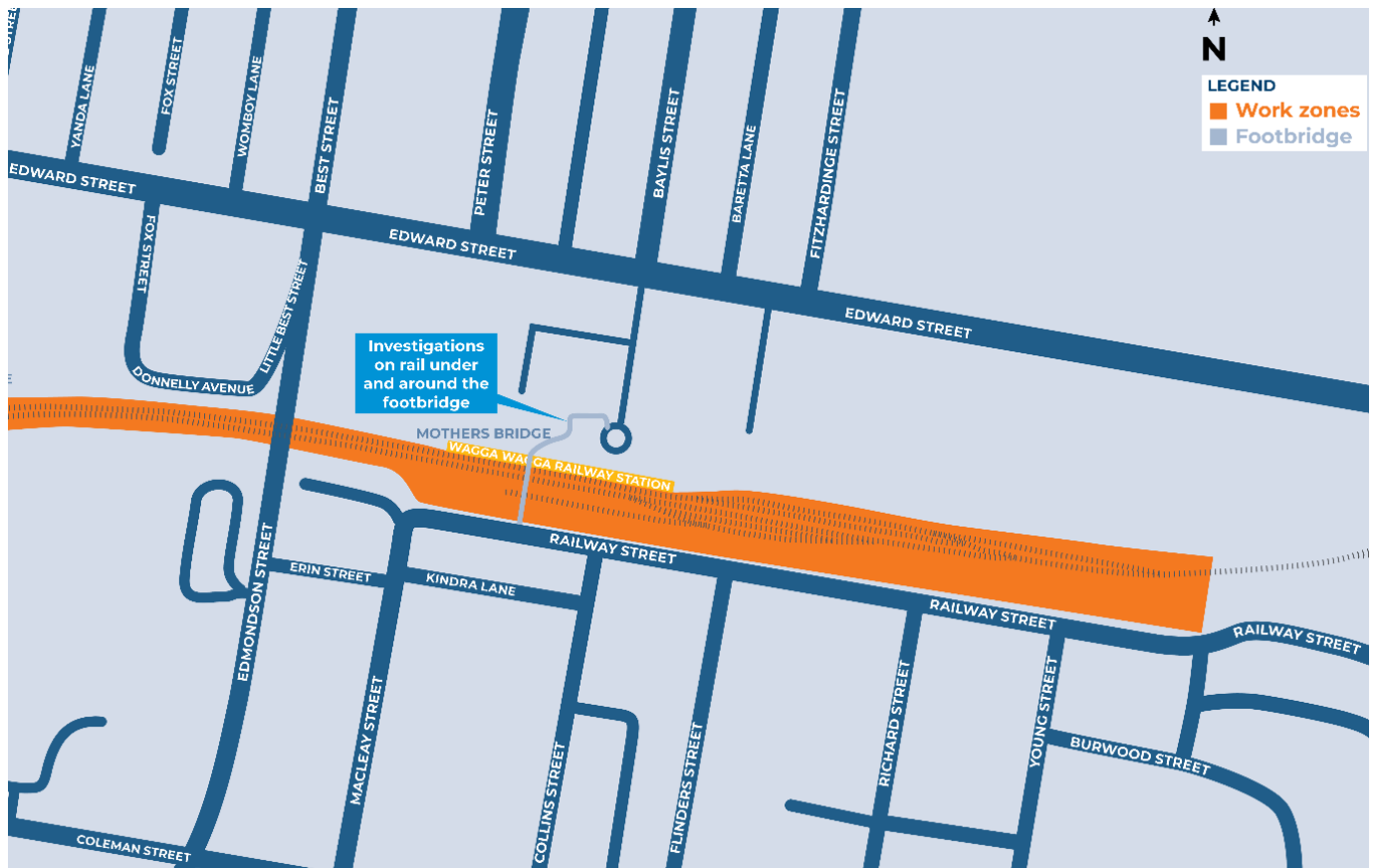
