

Updated Out-of-hours work, Wagga Wagga July 2025

Martinus has been engaged to construct the Albury to Illabo section of the Inland Rail project in New South Wales.

As part of this construction work, Martinus will undertake out-of-hours work at and around the Edmondson Street precinct in Wagga Wagga, which we have previously notified you of.

There has been a change to these dates. Please note the **new** dates for these out-of-hours works in the table below.

The work will occur outside our standard construction hours between **6pm** and **7am** on the following shifts, including contingency shifts if required.

Work will be undertaken out-of-hours to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to our workers and road users.

Work being done

- delivery of oversize electricity poles

- installing new electricity pole base at Little Best and Edmondson Street
- soil contamination testing as part of the upcoming Edmondson Street Bridge Upgrade.

What is soil contamination testing?

Soil contamination testing involves collecting soil samples from different areas of a site to check for potentially harmful substances like heavy metals, chemicals or other pollutants.

These samples are then analysed in accredited laboratories to determine the type and concentration of pollutants if present.

This practice is essential for evaluating environmental health risks, guiding remediation efforts and ensuring compliance with environmental regulations.

Temporary traffic changes near you

To safely carry out this work, Edmondson Street Bridge will be closed to all traffic between **8pm** and **5am** on the dates outlined **between 7 July and 17 July**. Traffic will be detoured through Erin Street and Railway Street.

Traffic management will be in place on streets where required to minimise traffic disruptions and ensure the safety of our workers and all road users.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, obey signs and traffic control, expect traffic delays and allow extra travel time during this work.

What can I expect?

- temporary road closures at Edmondson Street and traffic management will be in place, with detour signage to assist those impacted by road closures
- access for residents and properties will be maintained under traffic control

- reduced speed limits of 40km/h near work areas
- delivery of materials and equipment to the site
- nearby residents will hear some noise and notice vibrations during this time.

Machinery used

Equipment used for work includes but is not limited to hand-held tools, drill rig, excavator, tipper truck, water carts, Frana crane, vacuum truck, mobile light tower, semi-trailer, traffic management equipment and light vehicle.

How we're managing impacts

Machinery and other plants and equipment working in different areas throughout the night.

The machinery and equipment generate light, noise, and vibration. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by:

- planning activities close to residents within standard construction hours and scheduling noisy activities earlier in the night, where possible
- use of non-tonal reversing alarms on all equipment and turning off equipment when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours
- positioning of machines and directing temporary lighting down and away from homes where possible
- monitoring noise to manage any potential impacts and adjusting our work, where possible
- works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Approval Conditions.

Cancellation and change of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled or changed at short notice due to weather and other factors. Should this occur, impacted residents will be advised.
