- Nearby residents may experience some noise and additional construction workers and vehicles in the area.

How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced speeds
- An arborist will assess all trees before removal
- All areas will be inspected by a qualified wildlife handler for wildlife before tree removal works commence. If fauna is encountered, works will cease until a wildlife handler has safely relocated the animal.

Machinery used


Compaction roller, excavators, tippers, elevated work platforms, woodchipper, trucks and support vehicles and workers with hand tools.
