Watermain relocation works will be undertaken along the new Shared User Path, recently installed at Hamilton Street in Broadford.

What can I expect?

- · Round-the-clock works, 7am Friday 8 August to 5pm Sunday 10 August
- Traffic management will be required where works are occurring close to roads. Pedestrian access will be maintained via the pedestrian detour at **Broadford Station**
- Reduced speed limits of 40km/h near works
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high levels of noise at times. Residents impacted by high levels of noise will be contacted directly.

Machinery used

Heavy and light vehicles including trucks, excavators, non-destructive digging trucks, welding tools, cranes and concrete trucks.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place for noise, dust and vibration.


Cancellation or extension of works
