

48h road closure and bridge works Hamilton Street bridge, Broadford 1 to 30 Sept 2025 (with night works)

John Holland will demolish the existing Hamilton Street bridge, lower the rail track under the bridge and continue construction of the new bridge in September. There will be a 48-hour full road closure of Hamilton Street bridge to facilitate these works.

Work being done

- Demolition of the existing Hamilton Street bridge
- Removal, lowering and reinstatement of the rail track below the bridge
- Construction of access and piling pads within the rail corridor
- Utility relocation and connections
- Approved vegetation removal

Short-term closure of the Hamilton Street bridge

- The Hamilton Street bridge will be closed from 7am Saturday 13 September until 7am Monday 15 September
- The full bridge closure is required to demolish the existing Hamilton Street bridge
- A detour will be via Sunday Creek Road or the Hume Freeway. When using the detour, allow an additional 20-minute travel time or 30 minutes during peak times.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- **Round-the-clock works from 7pm Friday 12 September to 6pm Wednesday 17 September. Hamilton Street bridge will be closed for a 48-hour period during this time**
- Outside of the 48 hour closure, long-term temporary traffic changes will continue, including single lane shuttle flow over the new section of Hamilton Street bridge.
- Additional traffic changes to the Hamilton and High streets intersection, reduced speeds and vehicle and pedestrian detours.

- Increased construction vehicles on High Street, Dairy Lane, Ferguson Street (east) and Powlett Street (south)

- Construction vehicles accessing the rail corridor via Broadford Railway Station, Ferguson Street (south) and Jamieson Street
- Residents impacted by out-of-hours work will be notified ahead of time
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Non-destructive digging truck, excavators, tipper trucks, cranes, piling rigs, compaction rollers, loaders, graders, concrete trucks, delivery truck and trailers, rollers, hi-rail dump trucks, workers using hand tools, light towers, traffic management equipment, and survey equipment.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Wayfinding signage along vehicle and pedestrian detours
- Environmental controls will be in place.

Cancellation or extension of works

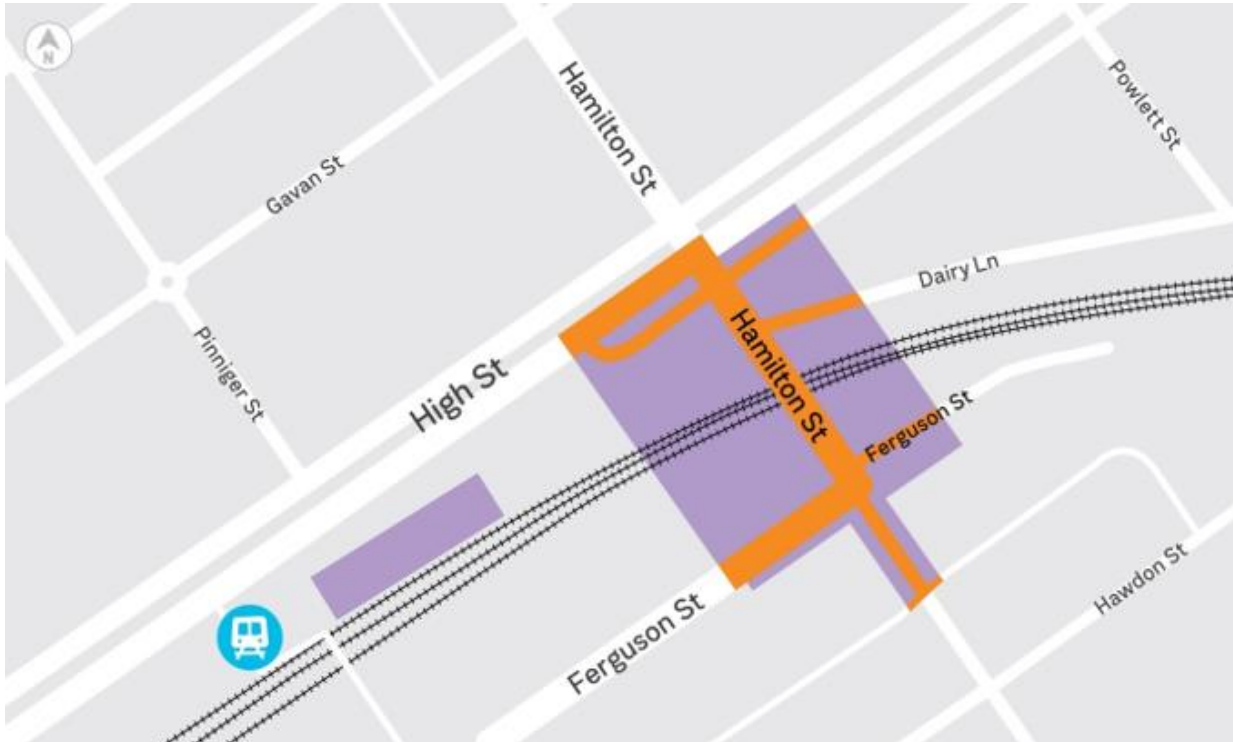
Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.

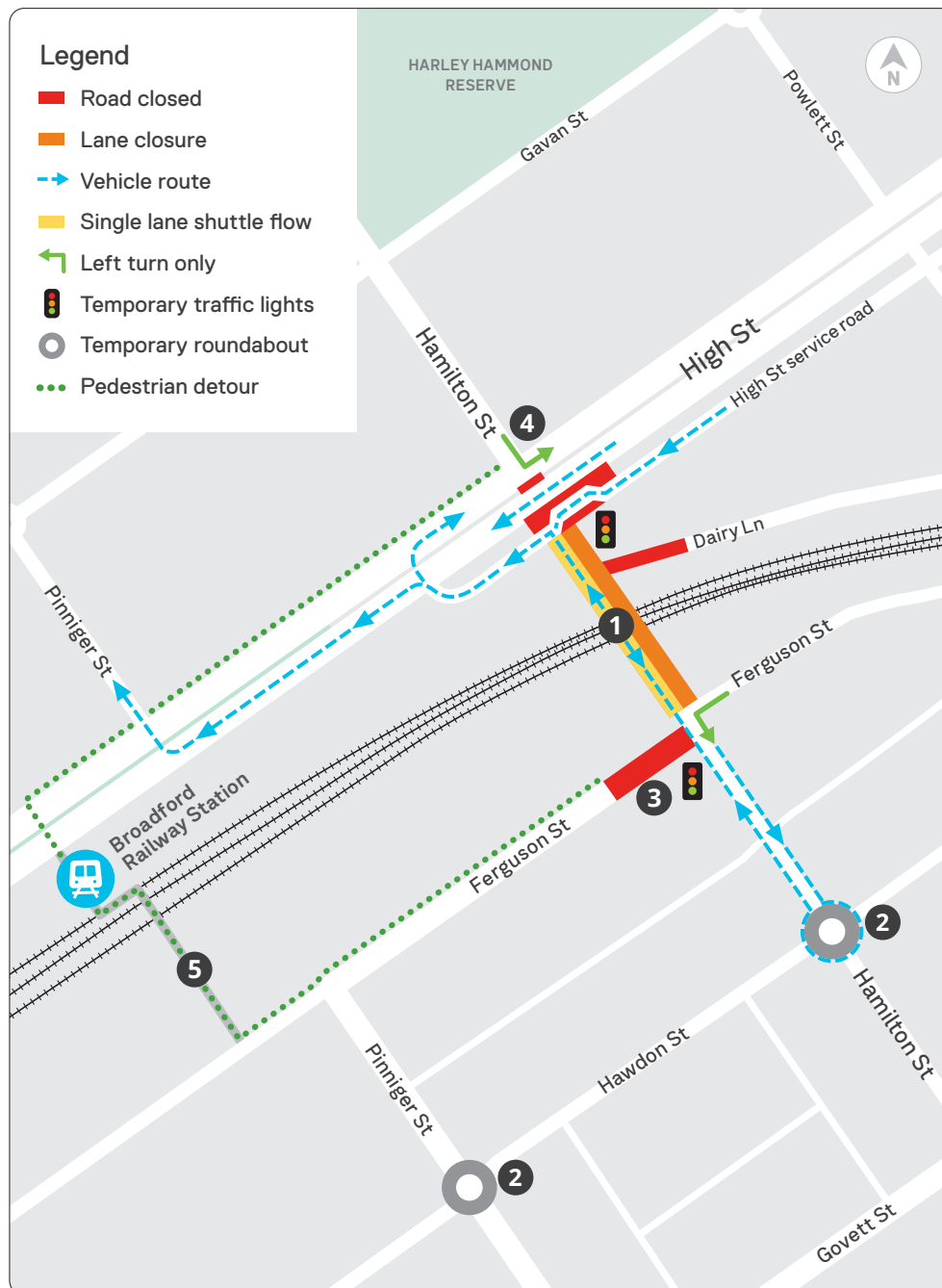

What's happening at the Hamilton Street bridge?

As we construct the new Hamilton Street bridge, traffic conditions around the worksite will change. Reduced speeds and traffic management will be in place. Please allow extra travel time and follow all directions.



Road and pedestrian changes

- To access the area needed to construct the new bridge, single lane shuttle flow and temporary traffic lights combined with traffic management will be in place.
- To support traffic flow temporary roundabouts will remain in place at intersections along Hawdon Street, with left turn only from Fergusson Street (north) onto Hamilton Street.
- To access the area needed to upgrade the road, a section of Fergusson Street (south) will remain closed.
- To reduce congestion along High Street, through traffic from Hamilton Street will be closed at the High and Hamilton streets intersection.

 - From High Street over the bridge will be via left turn from the High Street service lane
 - From Hamilton Street bridge to High Street via High Street service lane
 - From High Street to Hamilton Street (north) via Pinniger Street
 - Left turn only from Hamilton Street (north) onto High Street.
- To keep pedestrians safe during bridge works the pedestrian detour will remain available via the Broadford train station.

Stay alert. Look and listen for trains.
