Work being done

- Construction of piling pad and crane pad
- Partial demolition of bridge retaining wall
- Removal of overhead wires across the railway line
- Utility relocation works under the railway line and High Street.
- Approved vegetation removal

What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays
- Works 7am-6pm on Saturday 13 and Sunday
 14 September during 60-hour rail possession
- Round-the-clock works for under bore 7am
 15 September to 5pm 17 September
- Temporary shuttle flow, traffic management, and reduced speed limits
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Excavators, tandems, grader, rollers, dozers, concrete pump, non-destructive digging trucks, directional drill, light towers, workers using hand tools and survey equipment, traffic management equipment and signage.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place
- An arborist and qualified wildlife handler will assess all trees before removal.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.
