Traffic changes and bridge works Short Street bridge, Broadford 1 to 30 September 2025 (with night works)



John Holland will continue construction of a new bridge at Short Street during September. These works require long-term temporary traffic changes.

Work being done

- · Bridge foundation and abutment works
- · Delivery and storage of bridge beams
- Excavation and retaining wall construction in the rail corridor, in preparation for track lowering
- Service investigations, surveys, utility relocations and drainage works
- Roadworks on the corner of Burges Lane and along Cameron Parade and Rupert Street to provide a temporary detour route.

What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays
- Round-the-clock works from 7pm Friday 12
 September to 6pm Wednesday 17 September.
- Short-term additional traffic management between Thursday 4 September - Saturday 6 September, during bridge beam delivery
- Long-term temporary traffic changes will be in place including single-lane shuttle flow over the Short Street bridge
- Short Street access from Rupert and Sutherland streets will be temporarily closed with detours in place from mid-September
- Traffic management, reduced speeds and vehicle detours
- Increased construction vehicles on Sutherland Jamieson and Rupert streets
- Construction vehicles accessing the rail corridor via Jamieson Street

Nearby residents may notice some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Non-destructive digging truck, excavators, tipper trucks, cranes, jack hammers, concrete trucks, piling rigs, compaction rollers, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders, concrete trucks, workers using hand tools, light towers, survey equipment, and traffic management equipment.

How we're managing impacts


- · Traffic management and reduced road speeds
