### What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays
- Extended hours 5am-7pm Saturday 13 to **Sunday 14 September**
- Construction vehicles accessing the rail corridor via Sharps and Taylors Road. Traffic management and reduced speeds will be in place
- Nearby residents may hear some noise and can expect some additional construction workers and vehicles in the area.

### How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls will be in place.

### Machinery used

Compaction roller, excavators, tippers, nondestructive digging truck, elevated work platforms, woodchipper, boring machine, trucks and support vehicles and workers with hand tools.


### Cancellation or extension of works
