

Traffic changes and bridge works

Short Street, Broadford

1 to 31 October 2025

John Holland will continue works to construct the new Short Street bridge during October. There will be changes to traffic conditions, including temporary road closures during this time.

Work being done

- The new Short Street bridge will be lifted into place by a 650-tonne crane, positioned within the Rupert Reserve works site in late October
- Replacement and commissioning of power poles and overhead powerlines, requiring the short-term closure of Short Street bridge
- Construction of deck slabs and supporting bridge walls
- Bridge abutment and retaining wall works
- Service investigations, surveys and drainage installation works
- Demolition of 16 Short Street.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- **Sunday 26 October**, Short Street bridge will be closed between 8am-12pm during power pole and powerline works. A detour will be in place via Sunday Creek Road or the Hume Freeway. Please allow an additional 20 minute travel time or 30 minutes during peak times
- **Monday 27 October**, extended work hours 4.30am-7.30pm to install the new Short Street bridge. There will be delays to single lane shuttle over Short Street bridge, 4.30am-6am
- A small section of Rupert Street will be closed from late October, with a detour via Burges Lane, Cameron Parade and Mia Mia Road

- Single lane shuttle flow to extend south along Short Street between 7am-6pm, Thursday 23 October
- Traffic management, reduced speeds and vehicle detours
- Residents impacted by out-of-hours work will be notified ahead of time
- Residents impacted by interruptions to property services from utility upgrade works will be notified by the service provider
- Nearby residents may notice some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Bucket trucks, pole trucks, non-destructive digging truck, excavators, tipper trucks, cranes, jack hammers, piling rigs, compaction rollers, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders, concrete trucks, workers using hand tools, light towers, survey equipment, and traffic management equipment.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Wayfinding signage along detour routes
- Environmental controls will be in place
- Additional details of works and detours will be provided in October.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.

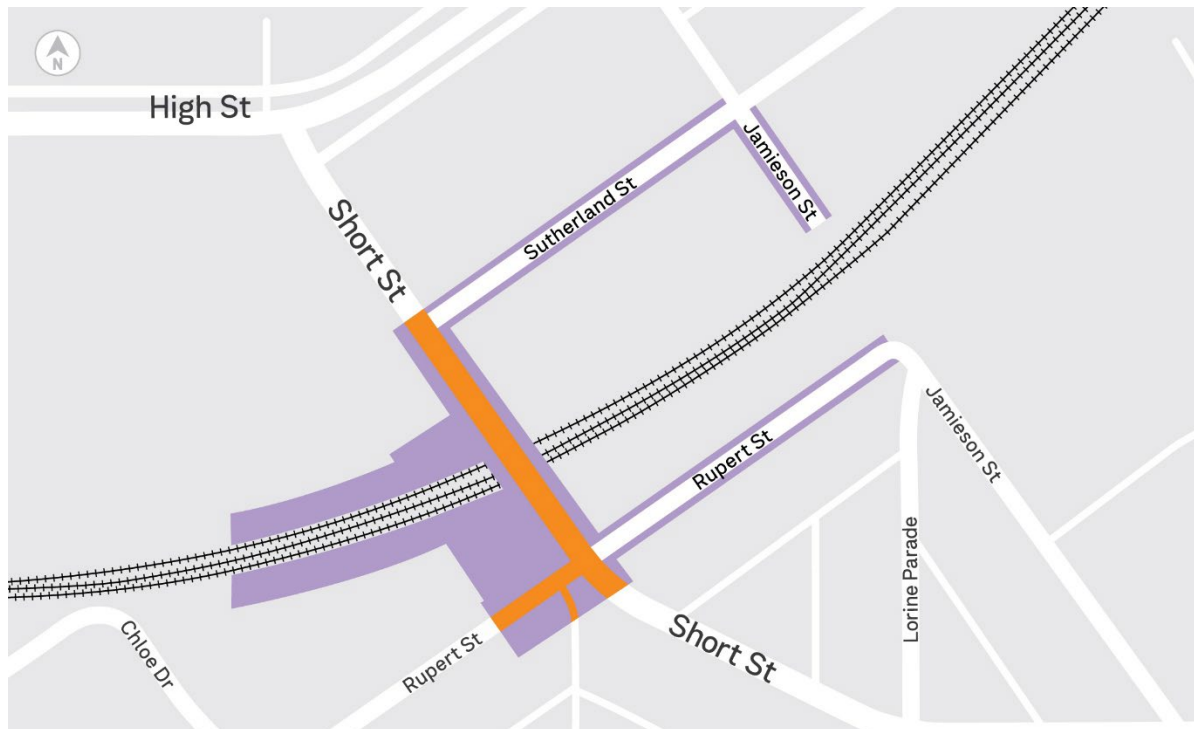
