John Holland will commence construction of two new access tracks along the rail line at Short Street in late October. These access tracks will be utilised until the end of construction.

## Work being done

- · Construction of access tracks along the rail line
- Tree removal for access tracks
- Redundant power pole removal in rail corridor
- Delivery of materials.

#### What can I expect?

- · Access to the tracks via the rear of the **Broadford Bowls Club will occur from late** October onwards
- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays.
- Extended works 4.30am-7.30pm Monday 27 October
- · Multiple truck movements daily into Broadford **Bowls Club**
- Traffic management, reduced speeds and vehicle detours
- Residents impacted by out-of-hours work will be notified prior
- Nearby residents may notice some noise and vibration.

#### Machinery used

Graders, excavators, delivery trucks, rollers and water carts.

### How we're managing impacts


- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
