- Delivery of rail and construction materials
- Minor works on bridge.

What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Saturday
- Extended work hours 7am-6pm Sunday 26 October
- Extended work hours 1am-8pm Monday 27 October
- Traffic management and reduced speeds on Hume Freeway bridge, Monday 27 and Tuesday 28 October
- Rail corridor access via the level crossing at Sharps and Taylors Road, Tallarook
- Increased trucks using Sanctuary Road and Gairns Lane
- Nearby residents may hear some noise and can expect additional construction workers and vehicles in the area.

How we are managing impacts

- · Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- An arborist will assess all trees before removal
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used


