Work being done

- Drainage installation and pavement works
- Preparation for track lowering including abutment and retaining wall works in the rail corridor
- · Construction of bridge deck and walls
- Pavement and drainage works along Catherine Court
- · Utility works
- · Approved vegetation removal.

What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays
- Round-the-clock works 7pm Sunday 16
 November to 6pm Wednesday 10 December
 These works will be undertaken during a V/Line
 possession when the Shepparton Line Upgrade
 works are undertaken. For changes to V/Line

- Overnight bridge closures 9pm-5am Monday
 24 November to Saturday 29 November.
- Additional details on round-the-clock works and overnight bridge closures will be provided to nearby residents throughout November
- A small section of Short Street will be closed, with a detour via the High Street service road.
 Vehicles will not be able to turn directly into Short Street from High Street.

- A detour will be in place via Sunday Creek Road or the Hume Freeway during this time.
 Allow an additional 20-minute travel time
- Additional truck movements to rail corridor via Broadford Bowls Club
- Travel delays, traffic management and reduced speeds across Broadford
- Detours in place via Burges Lane, Cameron Parade and Mia Mia Road
- Construction vehicles on Sutherland and Jamieson streets, and accessing the rail corridor via Short, Rupert and Jamieson streets
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Trucks, excavators, cranes, piling rigs, rollers, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders and light towers. Workers using hand tools and traffic management equipment.

How we're managing impacts


- · Traffic management and reduced road speeds
