John Holland will continue works to construct the new Short Street bridge in December 2025 and January 2026. Round-the-clock works and changes in traffic conditions will continue during this time.

Work being done

- Construction of retaining walls in the rail corridor
- Construction of bridge deck
- Installation of drainage and bridge barriers
- Pavement works and concrete pours
- Excavation and non-destructive digging
- Utility works.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
These works will be undertaken during a V/Line possession when the Shepparton Line Upgrade works are undertaken. For changes to V/Line services visit vline.com.au
- **Round-the-clock works will continue until 6pm Wednesday 10 December.**
A detour will be in place via Sunday Creek Road or the Hume Freeway during this time. Allow an additional 20-minute travel time
- **Overnight bridge closures 9pm-5am Monday 1 December to Sunday 7 December.**
A detour will be in place via Sunday Creek Road or the Hume Freeway during this time. Allow an additional 20-minute travel time
- Outside of the overnight closures, long-term temporary traffic changes will continue, including single lane shuttle flow over the Short Street bridge
- A small section of Short Street will be closed until early 2026, with a detour via the High Street service road

- Access to Short Street from Catherine Court will remain closed until early 2026, with detours via Burges Lane, Cameron Parade and Mia Mia Road
- Additional construction vehicles accessing the rail corridor via Short, Rupert and Jamieson streets and the Broadford Bowls Club
- Travel delays, detours, traffic management and reduced speeds across Broadford
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Trucks, excavators, cranes, piling rigs, rollers, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders, concrete pump, telehandler and franna cranes. Workers using hand tools and traffic management equipment.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Wayfinding signage along detour routes
- Environmental controls in place.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.


