

Inner Darling Downs and Southern Darling Downs Community Consultative Committee

The joint Inner and Southern Darling Downs Community Consultative Committee (IDD and SDD CCC) meeting was held at Pittsworth Bowling Club on Wednesday 12 November 2025.

This summary provides an overview of the meeting and ensures information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting record and the Committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website.

The meeting was chaired by Bill Armagnacq, Chair for IDD CCC. The meeting was attended by 16 of 25 members from IDD and SDD CCC.

The meeting provided the Committee and community members with a general update on the progress of the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie section of Inland Rail.

The meeting was attended by Gerard Coggan, Queensland Coordinator-General, two members of his office and 10 community members.

The meeting included an update from the Coordinator-General regarding the assessment process and consideration of submissions for the revised draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie section.

Inland Rail updated attendees on the recent consultation period for the revised draft EIS, upcoming field surveys and investigations and property matters including land acquisition and corridor protection.

Members asked a range of questions about Inland Rail and the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie project including the revised draft EIS, the review of submissions and the approval process. Other matters raised included property acquisition, biodiversity offsets and corridor protection.
