

Bridge abutment excavation Edmondson Street bridge January 2026



Martinus is removing the bridge abutments at Edmondson Street during January 2026 as part of the Albury to Illabo section of Inland Rail.

Work being done

Work crews will remove large volumes of material from both the Edward Street side and the Edmondson Street (Kildare Catholic College) side of the bridge.

High impact activities are scheduled during the school holiday period to minimise disruption when students return.

Pedestrian safety:

Please be aware of increased construction vehicle movements around Edmondson Street bridge. Traffic conditions have changed and large trucks are moving in and out of work sites at reduced speeds.

Please use the pedestrian crossing button at the Edmondson and Edward Street intersection. Traffic light phasing will allow heavy vehicles to enter the site safely. Pedestrian footpaths will remain open during the abutment removal works.

Construction hours

All work will occur during standard construction hours 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, Monday to Saturday.

Activities will include:

- Mobilisation of heavy machines and equipment (e.g excavators, diggers)
- Vegetation clearing near South Wagga Public School, Edmondson Street site compound, and the rail corridor
- Daily excavation of bridge abutments and removal of materials
- Regular heavy vehicle movements transporting material from the site.

Machinery used

To complete the works there will be a combination of heavy machinery, mobile plant such as excavators, truck and trailers as well as the use of hand tools. Machinery will be selected on its ability to complete the works and minimise disruption to the community.

What can I expect?

Some of these construction activities are inherently noisy and cannot be avoided. Properties near the site can expect to hear:

- Excavation of rock, soil and pavement from the abutments
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment and construction materials
- Increased heavy vehicle and traffic at Edward Street and Edmondson Street intersection and Edmondson Street (near Erin Street)
- Temporary access restrictions in the work zone for safety, with traffic control as required.

- Works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Conditions of Approval
- All equipment and vehicles are fitted with low-tonal reversing alarms and will be turned off when not in use.

Heavy vehicles will stage in designated bays outside the site when not in use.

Cancellation of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled at short notice depending on weather and other factors. Should this occur, works will be rescheduled.
