

Out of hours heavy vehicle delivery

Mothers bridge February 2026

Martinus our construction contractor has commenced bridge piling works for the new Mothers bridge at Wagga Wagga railway station.

Piling is an important step in building strong foundations to support the new bridge, requiring the use of large and over-sized rigs and cranes. These machines cannot be transported on standard trucks, so they require special oversized vehicles

Works being done

Delivering over-sized heavy machinery to site, scheduled in early mornings out of normal construction hours when traffic is light to minimise disruption to the community and road network.

When will works occur

Heavy vehicles will deliver essential machinery to site under traffic control with a pilot vehicle **between 4:00am and 7:00am from 2–6 February**, travelling from **Wagga Wagga railway station** to the **site compound off Railway Street**.

What can I expect?


- Pilot vehicle and traffic control will be on site to safety move machinery
- Stop/ go traffic management during unloading
- Some noise while vehicles are unloaded
- Increased lighting during these times, we will direct lights away from homes.

How we're managing impacts

- Delivery will be planned out of hours to reduce impact to the traffic network and community
- Noise monitoring to reduce and use of non-tonal reverse alarms on all vehicles
- Vehicles turned off when not in use.

Machinery used

Pilot vehicle, flatbed semi-trailer, piling rig and mobile crawler crane.
