

# Out of hours water main works

## Wagga Wagga Yards

### January 2026

Martinus our construction contractor, is performing works at the Wagga Wagga railway yard.

These works require Riverina Water to conduct essential works on a water main within the rail corridor.

#### When will works happen

These essential works are scheduled over the weekend as they require a temporary water supply outage and limit disruption to the neighbouring schools.

- **Saturday 31 January 2026 8am – 10pm and Sunday 1 February 8am – 6pm**

#### What work will happen

- Local excavation to expose the valve location under the railway track
- Dismantle and replace valves and joints.

#### What to expect

- Deliveries of plant and equipment to site
- Construction machinery and equipment operation
- Excavation activity involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, and pavement as required
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment and construction materials.

#### How we're managing impacts

- Reduced speed and traffic control as required
- Noise and vibration monitoring will be monitored and managed in line with environmental requirements.

#### Machinery to be used

Heavy vehicles including a 6T excavator, plate compactor, Water cart, lighting towers, handheld tools and light vehicles.

#### Cancellation of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. Should this occur, work will be rescheduled and impacted residents will be contacted.
