Junee Yard

Out of hours works are scheduled to take place within the rail corridor near the Junee Recreational Centre and towards Kemp Street from:

- 3pm – 8pm Sunday 18 January and
- 6pm – 12am Monday 19 January

Out of Hours work will include:

- Disconnection and reconnection of electrical cables
- Electrical testing
- Signal testing

Machinery used:

Light vehicles, hand tools and water carts (if required).


Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicles will access and move within the work zone.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance
