

# Construction Update

## Albury

### February – April 2026

---



Our contractor Martinus is continuing construction works across various sites in Albury during **February to April 2026** between standard construction hours of **7 am and 6 pm Monday to Saturday**, subject to weather and ground conditions.

#### Possession Work

Martinus will also undertake works at various Albury sites during an extended track possession between **5 am on Saturday 28 February and 12 am on Sunday 1 March 2026**.

These works will be continuous, including night work during this period.

Track possessions are critical to the project, as no trains will run during this period. This helps us complete our work faster and minimise disruption to the community.

#### Work being done

- Modifying the top chords on the Murray River Bridge
- Ground drilling for concrete piling
- Drainage installation
- Signalling and track-related works
- Earthworks and excavations
- Utility investigations using a non-destructive digging machine (NDD)
- Establishing temporary site compound and laydown areas
- Environmental monitoring and ground surveys
- Construction material and equipment deliveries.

#### What can I expect?

- Heavy vehicles operating at several work sites
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required

- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

#### Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, mobile crane, EWP (elevated work platform), hi-rail machinery, oxy cutter, hydraulic hammer, concrete pump, generators, plate compactor, drum rollers, semi-trucks, lightning towers, loaders, vibrating rollers, excavators, water carts, survey equipment, skid steer, power washer, heavy and light vehicles.

#### How we're managing impacts

- Works scheduled to minimise noise impacts where possible
- Access for vessels on the Murray River will be maintained throughout the work
- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect to our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Approval Conditions.

#### Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.
