Junee and Junee to Illabo

Upcoming Works Scheduled

Regular construction work will occur during our standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday**.

However, a significant amount of out-of-hours work will be undertaken across multiple sites over varying timeframes. These activities are outlined below for each site. Noting that our next **rail possession will take place over the last weekend in February (28 February until 2 March 2026.)**

What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and construction materials
- You may see an increase in deliveries of plant, equipment and materials to all our site compounds, ancillary facilities and laydown areas in the lead up to the possession. (Illabo, Marina, Olympic Highway Underpass, Kemp Street and Wright's Oval.
- Construction machinery and equipment operation.

Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicle movements will be to and from site, as well as on site.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

Out-of-hours works for each site are outlined below, works will be continuous, including night works during this period unless stated otherwise.



Kemp Street bridge



- Asbestos removal may be necessary. Where identified, removals will be carried out by a licensed contractor with SafeWork NSW regulations and industry best practices. Strict safety measures will be in place to ensure there is no risk to community or the environment.
- Abutment excavation, demolition and loadout
- Rail corridor access track construction
- Piling works including platform construction
- Survey works
- Drainage channel temporary works for piling
- Utility investigation and relocation works
- Geotechnical investigations
- Contamination testing and remediation works (if encountered)
- Installation of temporary road signage, fencing and barriers.
