

Out of hours heavy vehicle delivery

Cassidy footbridge - February 2026

Martinus our construction contractor will commence bridge piling works for the new Cassidy footbridge at Wagga Wagga.

Piling is an important step in building strong foundations to support the new bridge, requiring the use of large and over-sized rigs and cranes. These machines cannot be transported on standard trucks, so they require special oversized vehicles.

Works being done

Delivering over-sized heavy machinery to site, scheduled in early mornings out of normal construction hours when traffic is light to minimise disruption to the community and road network.

When will works occur

Heavy vehicles will deliver essential piling machinery to the **Telstra Yard, 20 Brookong Ave** with a pilot vehicle under traffic control on

- 11 February between 4am – 7am
- 12 February between 4am – 7am

Plant will then be moved to **Cassidy Parade** on

- 19 February between 4am – 7am
- 20 February between 4am – 7am
- 21 February between 4am – 7am

Demobilisation from Cassidy Parade:

- 27 February between 4am – 7am
- 28 February between 4am – 7am
- 2 March between 4am – 7am

Machinery used

Pilot vehicle, flatbed semi-trailer, piling rig and mobile crawler crane, light vehicles and lighting towers.

What can I expect?

- Pilot vehicle and traffic control will be on site to safety move machinery
- Stop / go traffic management during unloading
- Some noise while vehicles are unloaded
- Increased lighting during these times, we will

direct lights away from homes.

How we're managing impacts

- Delivery will be planned out of hours to reduce impact to the traffic network and community
- Noise monitoring, use of non-tonal reverse alarms and turn off vehicles not in use.
