

Utility relocations and station precinct works

Euroa

1 to 31 March 2026

John Holland will continue utility relocation and construction of the Euroa Station Precinct upgrades during March.

Work being done

- Excavation, formwork and concreting for the new station pedestrian underpass
- Construction of new Anderson Street rail bridge
- Construction of the two new station platforms
- Culvert and drainage works
- Relocation of underground utilities in Anderson, Elliot, Frost and Scott streets
- Replacing electrical poles in Anderson Street
- Track formation
- Approved vegetation removal.

What can I expect?

- **Round-the-clock works within the station precinct between 6am Monday and 6pm Saturday, as required**
- **Extended hours between 6am-6pm Sundays**
- Small sections of Anderson, Elliot, and Scott streets may be temporarily closed during utility relocation works. Impacted residents will be notified
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Wayfinding signage along detours
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used

Cranes, excavators, trucks, earthmoving plant, roller, under-bore machine, concrete trucks, jack hammers. Workers using hand tools, traffic management and survey equipment.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.


