John Holland will continue excavation and piling works during March in preparation for the upcoming track lowering under the Hume Freeway bridge at Tallarook.

Work being done

- Construction of deflection and retaining walls
- Piling
- Widening of embankments and earthworks
- Installation of drainage
- Track formation.

What can I expect?

- **Low impact round-the-clock works from Monday to Saturday**
- **Extended hours between 6am-6pm Sundays**
- Rail corridor access via the level crossing at Sharps and Taylors Road, Tallarook
- Increased truck use along Gairns Lane, and Sanctuary and Main roads
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and can expect additional workers and vehicles in the area.

How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used


