

Pedestrian underpass mural painting Wangaratta Station 20 February to 15 March 2026

What is happening?

The pedestrian underpass at Wangaratta Station is being painted with a mural, which is a requirement of the Wangaratta Station Precinct heritage permit.

The concrete walls of the underpass and the pedestrian access ramp walkways will be painted by Yorta Yorta artist Tommy Day.

Work will begin on Friday 20 February and is expected to be completed by Saturday 15 March.

What can I expect?

- Works 7am-6pm Friday 20 February
- Works 7am-7pm, Monday 23 February to Saturday 15 March, including weekends
- Partial closure of the underpass and entrance paths, pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Workers using painting equipment including aerosols, drop sheets and scissor lift.

Machinery used

Scissor lift, painting equipment including aerosols.

How we're managing impacts

- Safe access maintained using bollards, fencing and hi-vis tape
- Clear signage indicating works in progress
- Partial closure of pedestrian walkways
- Spotters used during high-risk activities including movement of plant
- Controlled use of aerosol paints
