## Work being done

- Construction of deflection and protection walls
- Delivery of materials.

## What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-6pm Saturdays**
- Additional trucks along Seymour-Avenel Road and accessing the rail corridor near Kookaburra Lane
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration and can expect additional construction workers and vehicles in the area.

## How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management, reduced road speeds and single-lane shuttle flow where required
- Environmental controls in place.

## Machinery used

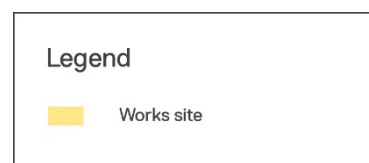
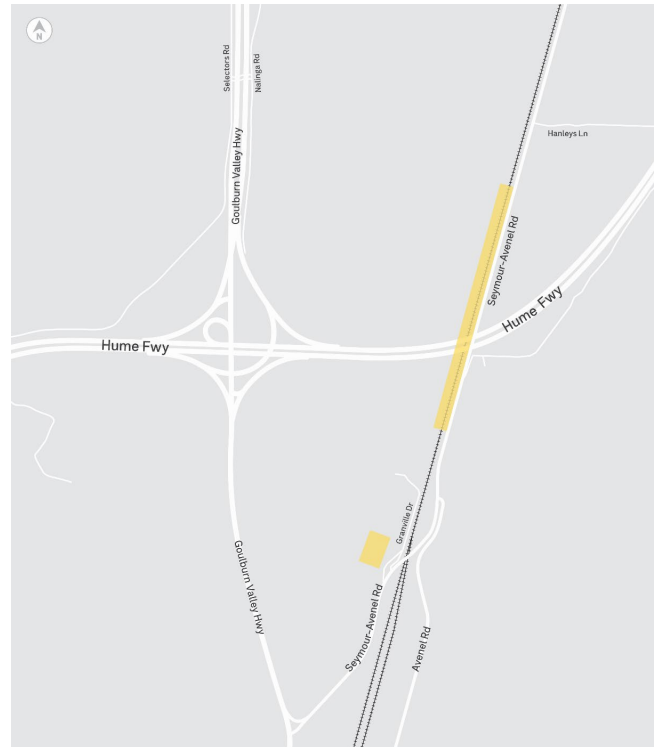
Excavators, tippers, non-destructive digging truck, hi-rail plant, cranes, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, and support vehicles. Workers using hand tools, traffic management and survey equipment.
