John Holland will continue works during April to prepare for the upcoming track lowering under the Hume Freeway bridge at Tallarook.

## Work being done

- Construction of bridge protection and retaining walls
- Track formation and drainage installation.

## What can I expect?

- **Low impact round-the-clock works from Monday to Saturday**
- **Extended works 6am-6pm Sundays**
- Increased truck access to the rail corridor via the level crossing at Sharps and Taylors Road
- Increased truck use along Gairns Lane, and Sanctuary and Main roads
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration and can expect additional construction workers and vehicles in the area.

## How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place.

## Machinery used

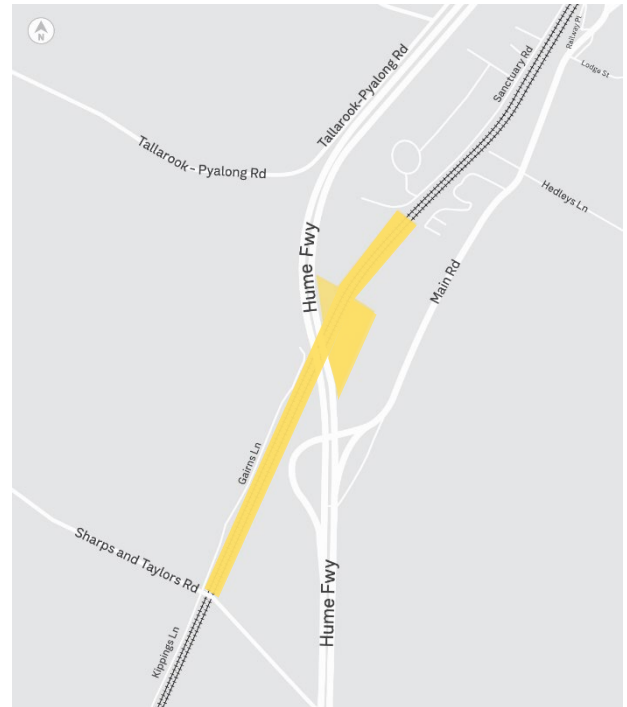
Trucks, excavators, tippers, graders, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, hi-rail plant and cranes. Workers using hand tools and survey equipment.
