

Inner Darling Downs Community Consultative Committee

The Inner Darling Downs Community Consultative Committee (IDD CCC) meeting was held at Brookstead Hall on Thursday 19 February 2026.

This summary provides an overview of the meeting and ensures information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting record and the Committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website.

The meeting was chaired by Bill Armagnacq, Chair of the IDD CCC. The meeting was attended by nine of 10 committee members. Two members of the Office of the Coordinator-General and 14 people from the community were also in attendance.


The meeting updated the Committee and other attendees on the progress of the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie section.

Inland Rail shared information about the design refinement investigations for several locations along the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie section, the embankment trial and upcoming field surveys.

Members asked a range of questions about Inland Rail and the NSW/Qld Border to Gowrie section, including the approvals process for the revised draft EIS, availability of responses to submissions and how potential design refinements are being assessed.

Other matters raised included noise impacts, road connectivity and emergency access, flooding concerns between Pampas and Condamine, the purpose and scope of the embankment trial and management of biodiversity offset properties, including weeds and biosecurity.
