

# A2I Asbestos removal

## Edmondson Street bridge Wagga Wagga

### March 2026

Asbestos containing material including draining pipe will be removed from the Martinus site compound on Railway Street and under Edmondson Street bridge.

Martinus have engaged qualified removalists, Absolute Environmental Services Pty Ltd to remove this material safely. Removal will commence **from Monday 2 March– Saturday 14 March 2026.**

We want to assure community members that all removal activities are being carried out by a certified asbestos contractor in strict accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and industry best practice.

Removal will occur during our standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.**

If work is required outside these construction hours, impacted neighbours will be notified in advance.

#### Works being undertaken

- Safe removal of asbestos containing material
- Contaminated material will be excavated
- Plant and equipment to be decontaminated appropriately before leaving site

#### What can I expect

- Personnel in appropriate personal protective equipment such as respiratory protective equipment, hazmat suits, gloves and boot covers etc.
- Excavation activity involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, and pavement.
- Installation and welding of poly piping
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment and construction materials
- Deliveries of plant and equipment to site.
- Construction machinery and equipment operation.

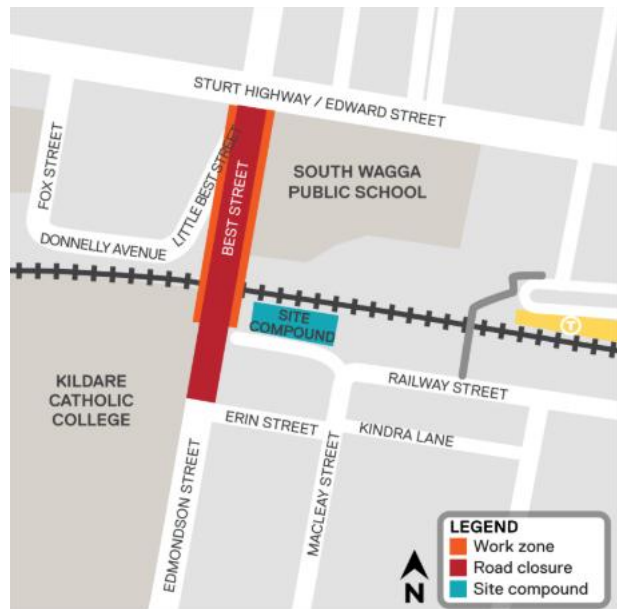
#### Temporary traffic changes near you

- Access to the corridor will be from the Wagga Wagga Multicultural Council carpark.
- Traffic controllers are in place to safely direct traffic as needed.

#### How we're managing impacts

- Contaminated materials to remain wet and/or covered to avoid airborne fibres
- Materials will be tested on site
- Use of hand tools instead of power tools
- Where possible, keeping sheets intact
- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- All plant and equipment to be decontaminated before leaving site
- The asbestos is being disposed of to a licenced waste facility.

These measures ensure the work is completed safely, with controls in place to prevent any risk to the community or the surrounding environment.
