

Monthly update Junee and Junee to Illabo May 2026

Upcoming Track Possession

Martinus will carry out track and associated works within the rail corridor, between Junee and Illabo, during an extended track possession. Out-of-hours works will commence at **7am on Friday 1 May 2026** and conclude at varying times for each site as outlined below.

Junee to Illabo

Track Possession

- **Continuous night shift**
1 May Friday 7am until 6 May Wednesday 7am
- **Brabins Road level crossing will be closed 6pm on Friday 1 May until 6am on Monday 4 May 2026.**



- Detour route will be via Brabins Rd, Eurongilly Rd, Allawah Rd, Bethungra Rd.

- Level crossing works on Brabins Rd (Illabo)
- Geotechnical investigations
- Drainage, earthworks and culvert works

Out-of-hours construction

Construction activities:

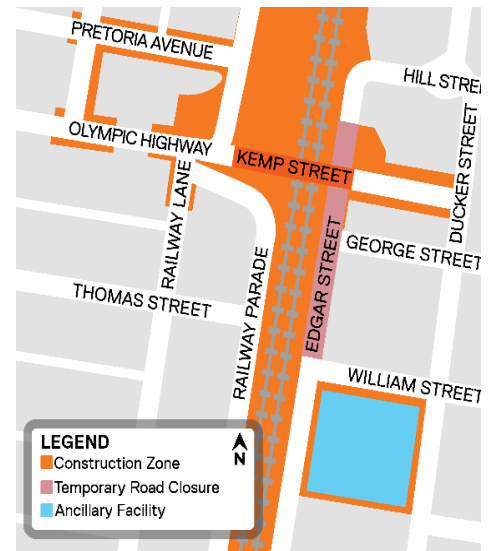

- Asbestos removal may be necessary. Where identified, removals will be carried out by a licensed contractor with SafeWork NSW regulations and industry best practices. Strict safety measures will be in place to ensure there is no risk to community or the environment.
- Abutment excavation, demolition and loadout
- Access track construction
- Piling works including platform construction

- Survey works
- Geotechnical investigations
- Contamination testing and remediation works (if encountered)
- Construction of concrete bridge piers and other substructure elements
- Installation of temporary road signage, fencing and barriers.
- Drainage works
- Earthworks and installation of reinforced soil walls (RSW)
- Utility investigation works

- Install of platform components



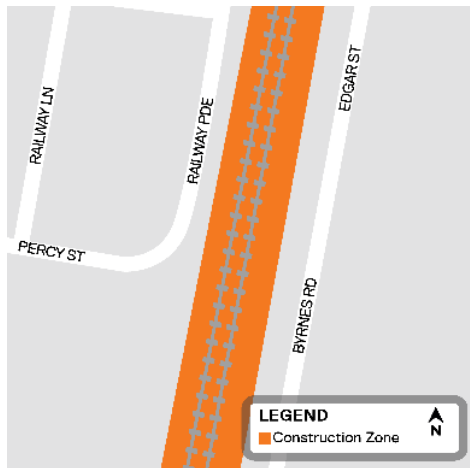

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicle movements will be to and from site, as well as on site.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and materials
- You may see an increase in deliveries of plant, equipment and materials to all our site compounds, ancillary facilities and laydown areas in the lead up to the possession.
- Construction machinery and equipment operation

Equipment list

- Backhoe, ballast equipment, compactor, compressor, concrete agitator truck, elevated work platforms, excavators, front end loader, generator, grinders, hand tools, hi-rail equipment, hydraulic tools, jumping jack, lighting towers, mobile

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
