

Road closures, round-the-clock works and heavy vehicle haulage

Broadford

27 April to 12 May 2026

John Holland will continue works across Broadford in April and May. These works require temporary road closures, round-the-clock works and constant heavy vehicle haulage across Broadford.

Work being done

Hamilton Street

- Bridge and pedestrian access works
- Installation of bridge screening posts
- Installation of drainage, lighting and landscaping

Short Street

- Lowering and replacement of rail tracks
- Installation of drainage
- Bridge construction works

Marchbanks Road

- Construction of piling pads and retaining wall
- Piling, soil nail wall and culvert extension works

What can I expect?

- **The Marchbanks Road bridge and a section of High Street will be closed:**

7pm Tuesday 28 April – 7am Thursday 30 April

7pm Thursday 30 April – 7am Friday 1 May

7pm Friday 1 May – 7am Tuesday 5 May

Hamilton and Short Street bridges will remain open during this time

- **The Short Street bridge will be closed overnight from 8pm-5am Tuesday 5 May**
A detour will be in place via Sunday Creek Road or Hume Freeway. Temporary single-lane shuttle flow will be reinstated over Short Street bridge from Wednesday 6 May until bridge works are completed
- **Temporary single-lane shuttle flow on Hamilton Street bridge overnight between 7pm-7am Saturday 2 May to Monday 4 May**
- **Residential access will be maintained**

- **Round-the-clock works 7am Monday 27 April to 6pm Tuesday 12 May**
- Heavy vehicles travelling round-the-clock between the four access points along the rail corridor, Last Street, Jamieson Street, Short Street, and the Broadford Bowls Club, to the project site at 231 High Street
- Refer to detour maps, traffic management and electronic signage for traffic changes. Please allow additional travel time and follow all detour signage and traffic management
- Additional traffic management at haulage route intersections
- Nearby residents may experience some noise, lighting from light towers and vibration.

Machinery used

Trucks, trailers, excavators, rollers, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders, dozer, tamper, concrete pump, asphalt paver and telehandler.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and wayfinding signage
- Environmental controls in place.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.

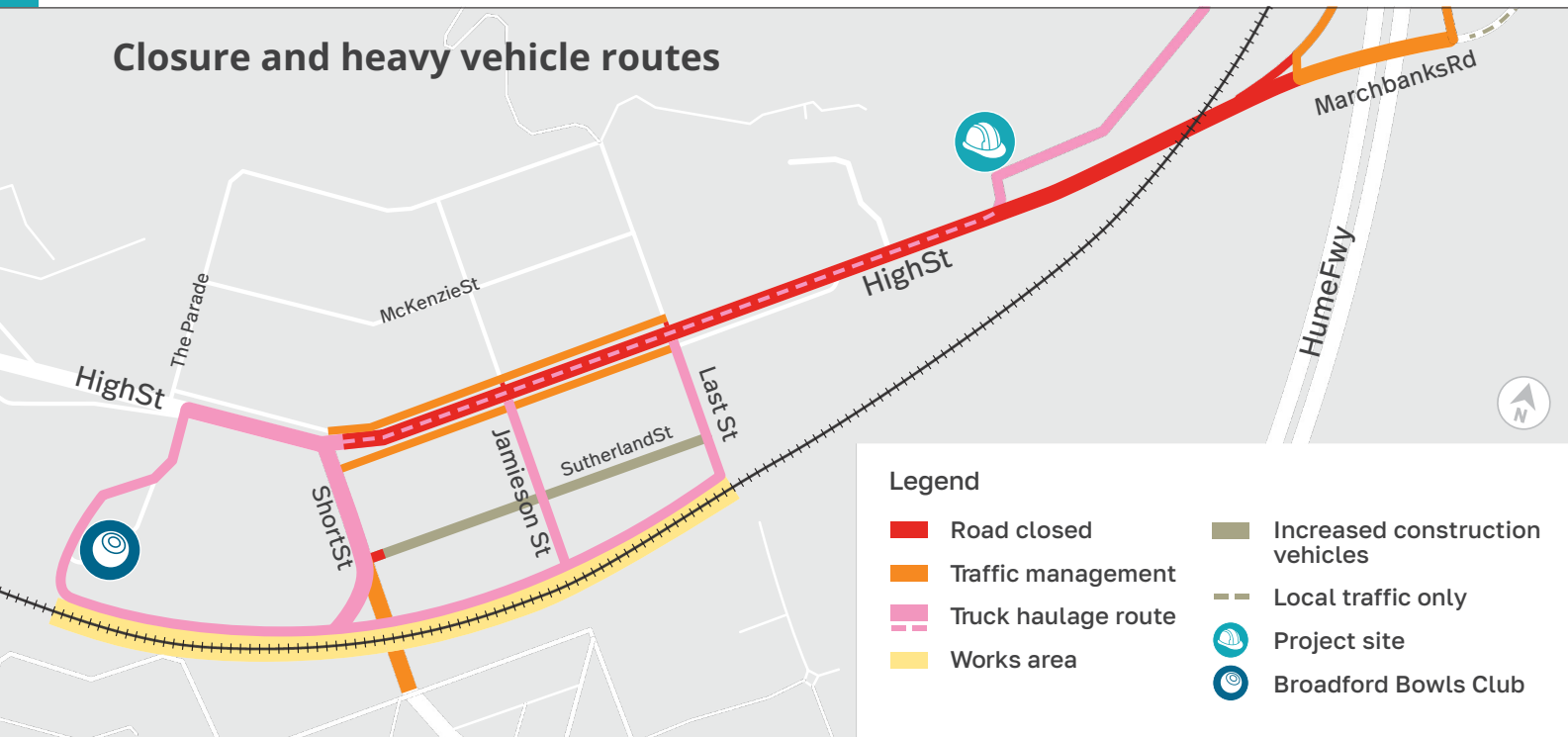
