

Audible Track Warning Signal Seymour, Tallarook, Broadford

29 April to 27 May 2026

John Holland is undertaking round-the-clock rail works to lower the rail tracks under the Hume Freeway bridges at Seymour and Tallarook and under Short Street bridge in Broadford.

An Audible Track Warning Signal will be used between 29 April and 27 May.

Work being done

- Track lowering works at Seymour, Tallarook and Broadford.

What can I expect?

- Round-the-clock works at the project sites in Broadford, Tallarook and Seymour, 7am Monday 27 April to 6pm Wednesday 27 May
- **Audible track warning signal located approximately 2.5km on either side of each track lowering site. This is to warn train drivers of the approaching worksite**
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and can expect additional workers and vehicles in the area.

Audible Track Warning Devices.

- Environmental controls are in place.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.
