Upcoming Traffic Changes

To facilitate upcoming road and bridge works for Kemp Street bridge in Junee there will be a staged approach to traffic detours as well as lane and road closures. A staged approach will be used to minimise disruption to road and pedestrian users as much as possible.

Dates are indicative and may change.

Stage 1

11 May until 18 May 2026

- Joffre Street will be closed to facilitate utility, geotechnical & contamination investigations.
- Pedestrian access across Joffre Street in Endeavour Park will remain open.
- Railway Lane and Railway Parade will be under traffic control with pedestrian access to be maintained. (1- day)
- Ducker Street opposite Kemp Street will be under traffic control (1-2 days)

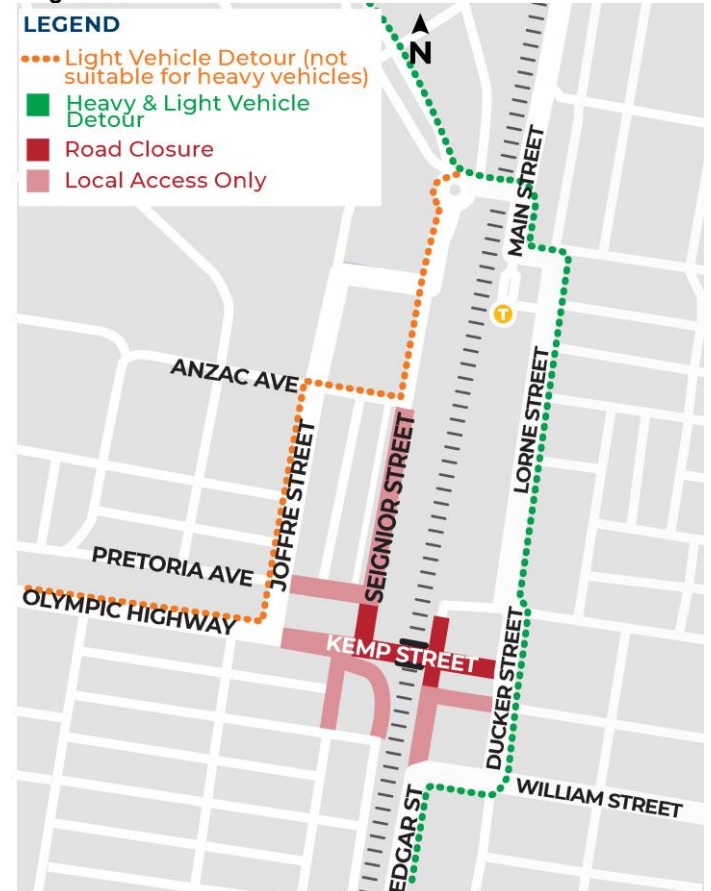


Stage 2

18 May until 17 August 2026

- Local traffic will be able to access Seignior Street via the service road.
- Seignior Street will be partly closed to facilitate utility, geotechnical & contamination investigations. (1-2 days in May). With the service road to remain open for local traffic only.
- Olympic Highway between Seignior Street and Joffre Street will be local traffic access only in a west bound direction. (late July)
- Railway Parade between Railway Parade and Railway Lane will be closed (late July)
- Additional notices will be provided in advance for these closures.

Bus Services

Currently, there are no impacts to regular bus and school services. Should this change, notice will be provided.

Community Shuttle

Community shuttle service will run uninterrupted until Stage 3 of traffic detours. During stage 3, the Seignior Street turnaround point will be shortened when drainage works are happening.

Temporary traffic changes near you

- Traffic detours will follow a staged approach to minimise impact on our near neighbours as much as possible.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

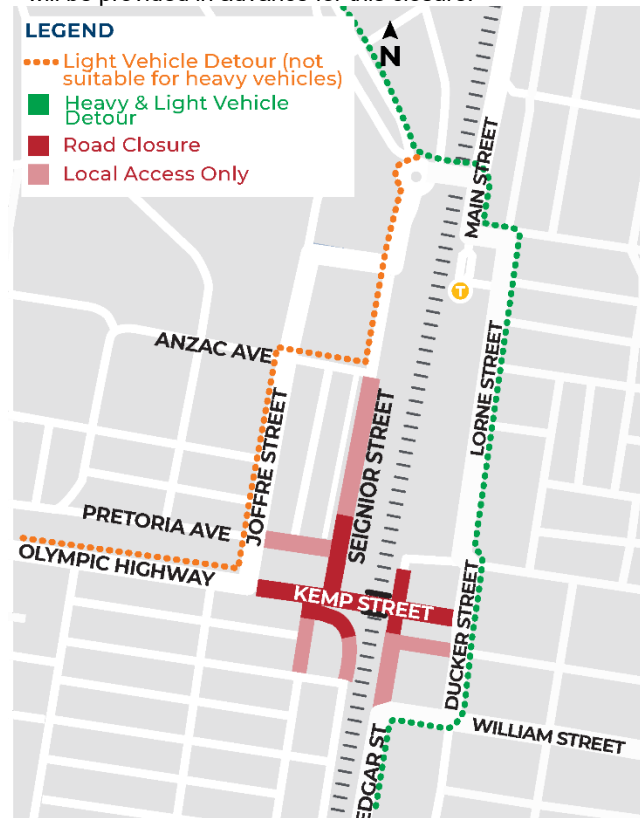
