

# Demobilisation works Hume Freeway bridge, Seymour 1 to 30 June 2026

John Holland has completed the rail track lowering and realignment works under the Hume Freeway bridge in Seymour. Site demobilisation will take place during June.

## Work being done

- Clearing of hardstand materials, site fencing and barriers.

## What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Saturdays**
- Traffic management, reduced road speeds and single-lane shuttle flow where required
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and can expect additional workers and vehicles in the area.

## How we are managing impacts

- Environmental controls in place.

## Machinery used

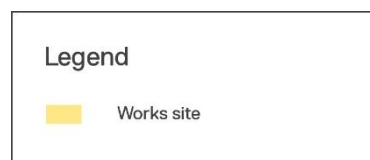
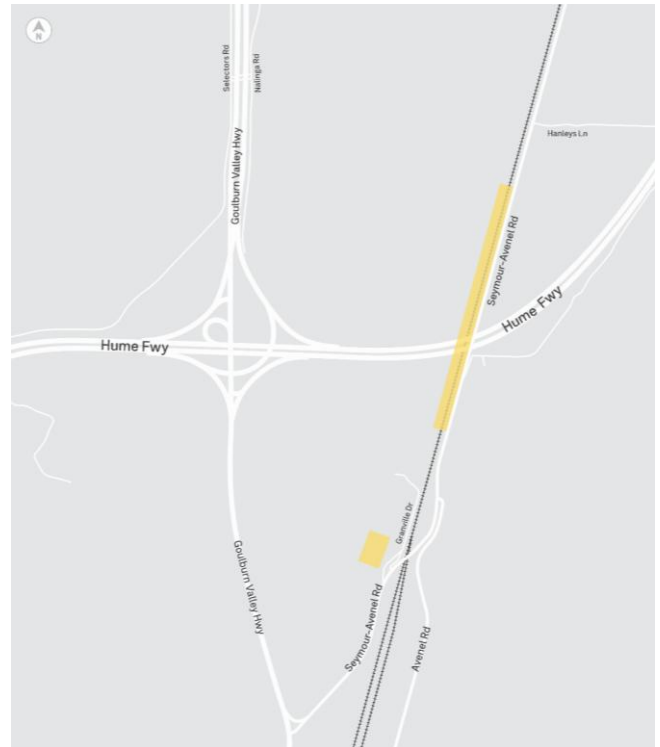
Excavators, tippers, cranes, elevated work platforms, truck and trailers and support vehicles. Workers using hand tools, traffic management and survey equipment.
