John Holland will continue works to lower and realign the rail tracks under the Hume Freeway bridge in Tallarook.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation while we carry out these works.

Work being done

- Track lowering
- Reinforcement of abutments
- Construction of retaining walls
- Installation of drainage.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Saturday**
- **Low impact overnight works under the Hume Freeway bridge, as required**
- Additional traffic management at haulage route intersections to support the increase of heavy vehicles
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and can expect additional workers and vehicles in the area.

How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used

Trucks, excavators, tippers, graders, elevated work platforms, piling rig, concrete trucks, hi-rail plant and cranes. Workers using hand tools and survey equipment.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.

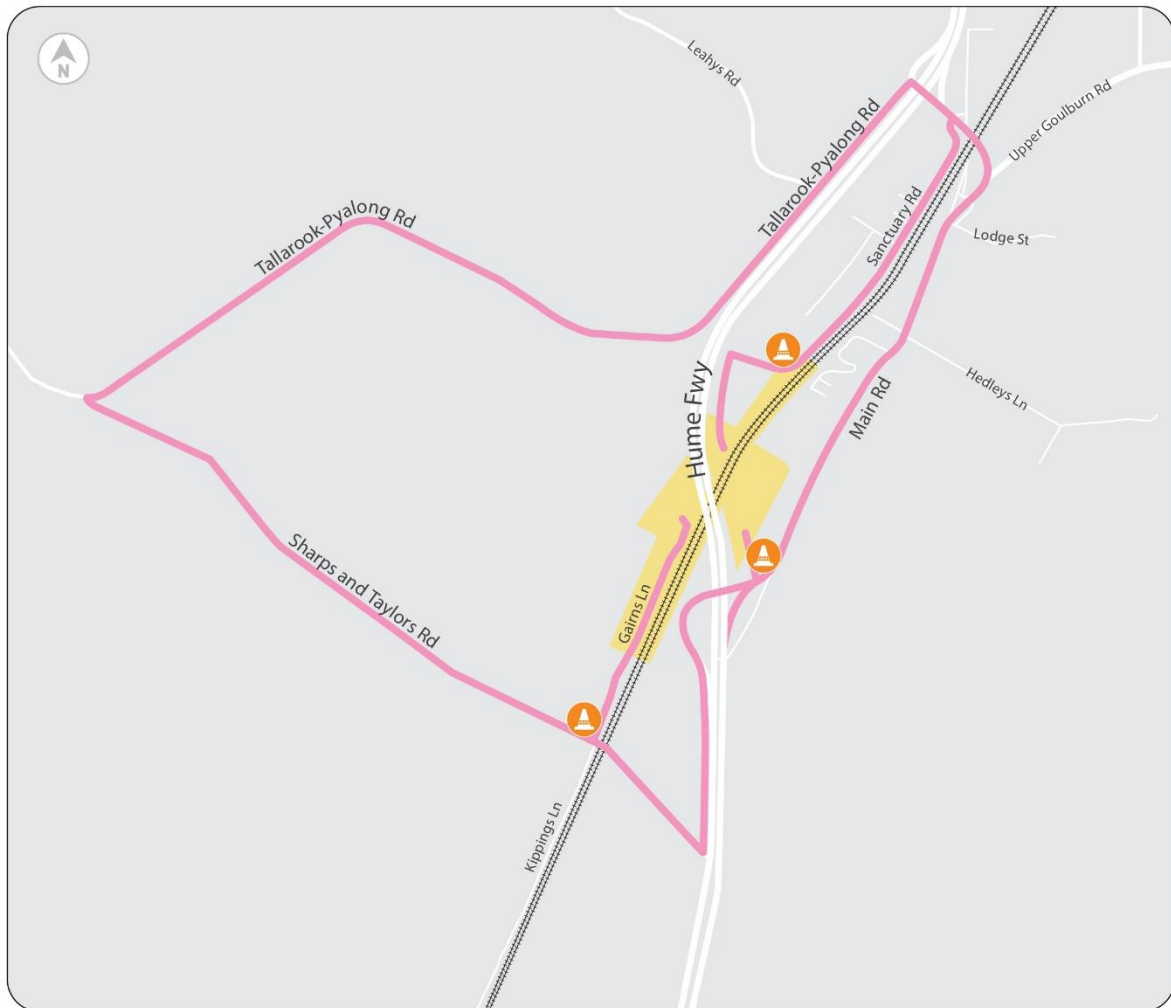
