Our contractor Martinus is continuing construction works across various sites in Junee and Junee to Illabo during the month of June.

- Track under bores for service installation and investigation
- Vegetation clearing
- Crane pad construction
- Material transportation between site compounds
- Site compound operation (Illabo and Marinna)
- Geotechnical activities
- Culvert and drainage works including concrete works
- Signalling activities along the Junee to Illabo alignment, including under boring and CSR installation to facilitate signalling equipment relocation.
- Lighting towers and generators will be used during out-of-hours construction periods
- Traffic control will be in place as needed

## Kemp Street bridge

### Standard construction hours:

7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday (subject to track availability).

### Construction activities:

- Asbestos removal may be necessary. Where identified, removals will be carried out by a licensed contractor with SafeWork NSW regulations and industry best practices. Strict safety measures will be in place to ensure there is no risk to community or the environment.
- Abutment excavation, demolition and loadout
- Access track construction
- Piling works including platform construction
- Survey works
- Geotechnical investigations (Seignior Street and Ducker Street)
- Contamination testing and remediation works (if encountered)
- Construction of concrete bridge piers and other substructure elements
- Installation of temporary road signage, fencing, barriers and scaffolding.
- Drainage works
- Earthworks
- Utility investigation and realignment works
- Retaining wall works
- Vegetation trimming
- Minor demolition works (footpath and kerbing)

## Traffic changes

**From 18 May 2026**, stage 2 of light and heavy vehicle detours will be in place surrounding Kemp Street bridge.

- Local traffic will be able to access Seignior Street via the service road.
- Seignior Street will be partly closed to facilitate utility, geotechnical and contamination investigations. (1-2 days in May). With the service road to remain open for local traffic only.
- Olympic Highway between Seignior Street and Joffre Street will be local traffic access only in a west bound direction. (late July)
- Railway Parade between Railway Parade and Railway Lane will be closed (late July)
- Heavy Vehicle detour will be via Goldfields Way, Old Junee Road onto either Queen Street or Main Street.

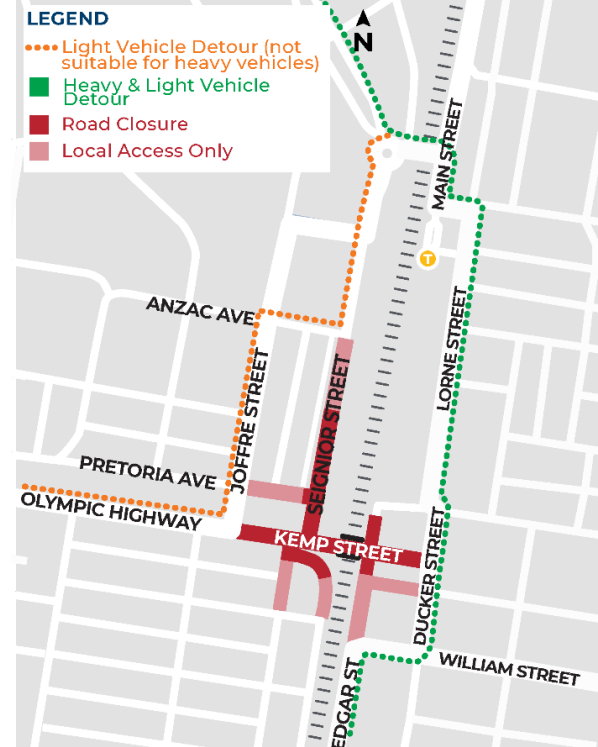
## Bus Services

Currently, there no impacts to regular bus and school services. Should this change, notice will be provided.

## Community Shuttle

Community shuttle service will run uninterrupted until Stage 3 of traffic detours. (August 2026 until project completion) During stage 3, the Seignior Street turnaround point will be shortened when drainage works are happening.

## How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

## Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicle movements will be to and from site, as well as on site.
- Traffic management will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

## What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and materials
- You may see an increase in deliveries of plant, equipment and materials to all our site compounds, ancillary facilities and laydown areas in the lead up to the possession.
- Construction machinery and equipment operation

- Backhoe, ballast equipment, compactor, compressor, concrete agitator truck, elevated work platforms, excavators, front end loader, generator, grinders, hand tools, hi-rail equipment, hydraulic tools, jumping jack, lighting towers, mobile cranes, plate compactor, positrack, rail saw, road sweeper, rollers, telescopic handler, truck & dogs, light and medium rigid vehicles, vacuum trucks, watercarts.
