Our contractor Martinus is continuing investigation work in Uranquinty from **Tuesday 23 June** to **Tuesday 7 July 2026** between standard construction hours of **7am** and **6pm Monday to Saturday**.

Work being done

- Geotechnical investigations
- Heritage investigations
- Environmental monitoring and ground surveys.

Machinery used

Equipment includes hand tools, a small excavator and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect to our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and adherence to the requirements as outlined in the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.
