

# Construction Update Yerong Creek July to August 2026



Our contractor Martinus will undertake construction works at Yerong Creek from **Friday 3 July to Monday 31 August 2026**.

## Hours of work

During standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**.

If work is required outside these hours, affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

## Work being done

- Underbore drilling and ground excavations
- Establishing a temporary site compound
- Geotechnical investigation, including non-destructive digging (NDD)
- Operating the temporary site compound
- Grubbing and vegetation removal, where required
- Removing materials and debris off-site
- Environmental monitoring, survey and track inspections
- Construction material and equipment deliveries

## What can I expect?

- Heavy vehicles operating at the work site
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required
- Temporary service interruptions may be required. Affected residents will be notified in advance by Riverina Water or Telstra
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

## Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, survey equipment, small drilling rig, welding equipment, loaders, excavators, drum rollers, compactor, semi-trucks, water carts, elevated work platforms (EWP), heavy and light vehicles.

## How we're managing impacts

- Works will be scheduled to minimise noise impacts where possible
- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls, where required, to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and adherence to the requirements outlined in the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

## Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

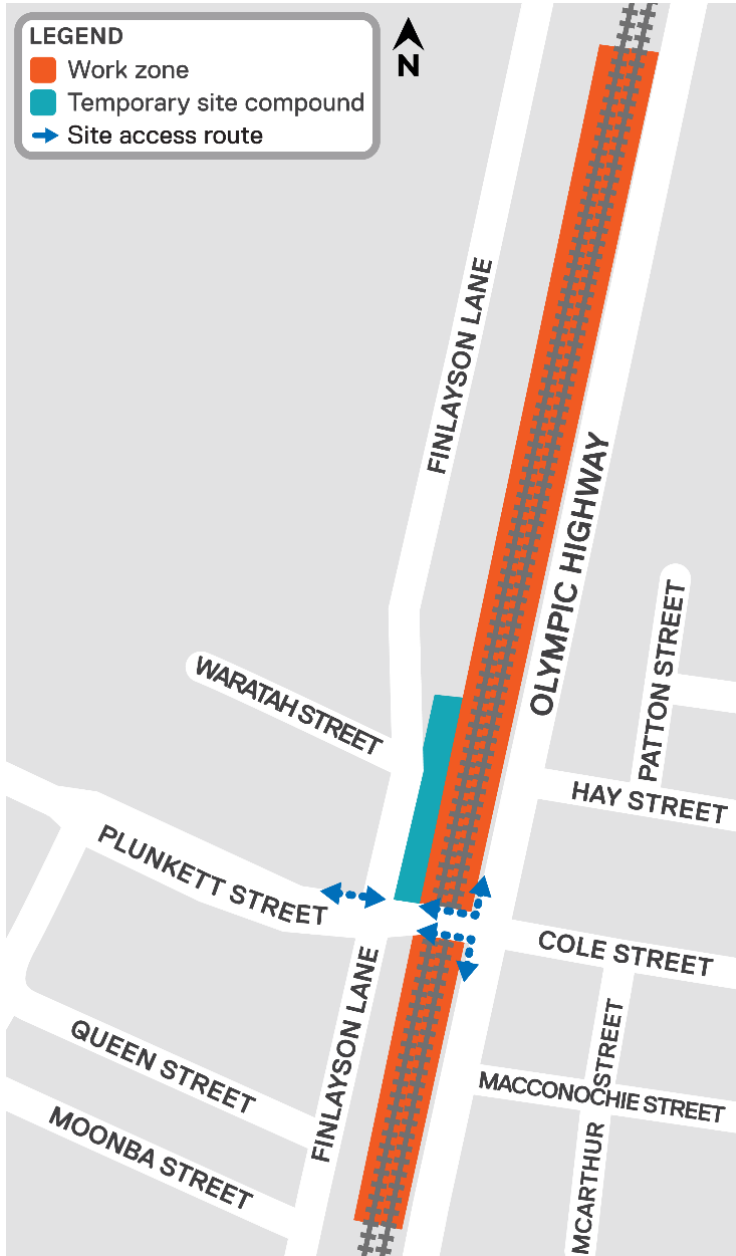
