

Road resurfacing and station precinct works

Euroa

1 to 31 July 2026

John Holland will continue construction of the Euroa Station Precinct upgrades and the Anderson Street vehicle underpass during July.

Work being done

- Excavation, piling, formwork and concreting for the new pedestrian and vehicle underpasses
- Construction of the two new station platforms, two new carparks and the station forecourt
- Resurfacing and kerbing works on Railway Street, between Binney and McGuinness streets
- Resurfacing, kerbing and crossover works on Anderson, Elliot and Hinton streets
- Culvert and drainage works
- Upgrades to street lighting on Railway, Anderson, and Binney streets
- Installation of signalling infrastructure at the Birkett Street level crossing
- Installation of additional site buildings near Elliot and Rowe streets, within the project compound
- Approved vegetation removal.

What can I expect?

- **Extended works 6am-6pm Monday to Saturday**
- **Low impact overnight works within the station precinct, as required**
- Temporary short-term single-lane shuttle flow at the Birkett Street level crossing, as required
- Temporary short-term single-lane shuttle flow along Railway, Anderson and Binney streets during street lighting upgrades
- Temporary single-lane one-way traffic on a section of Railway Street between Binney and McGuinness streets

- Railway Street carpark is closed
Public parking is available at the Euroa Hotel carpark, off McGuinness Street
- Coaches replace all V/Line passenger services at Euroa
- Railway Street bus stop relocated to McGuinness Street for V/Line and Public Transport services
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Wayfinding signage along detours
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used

Cranes, excavators, trucks, earthmoving plant, grader, roller, under-bore machine, concrete trucks, jack hammers. Workers using hand tools, traffic management and survey equipment.

Cancellation or extension of works


Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be notified.

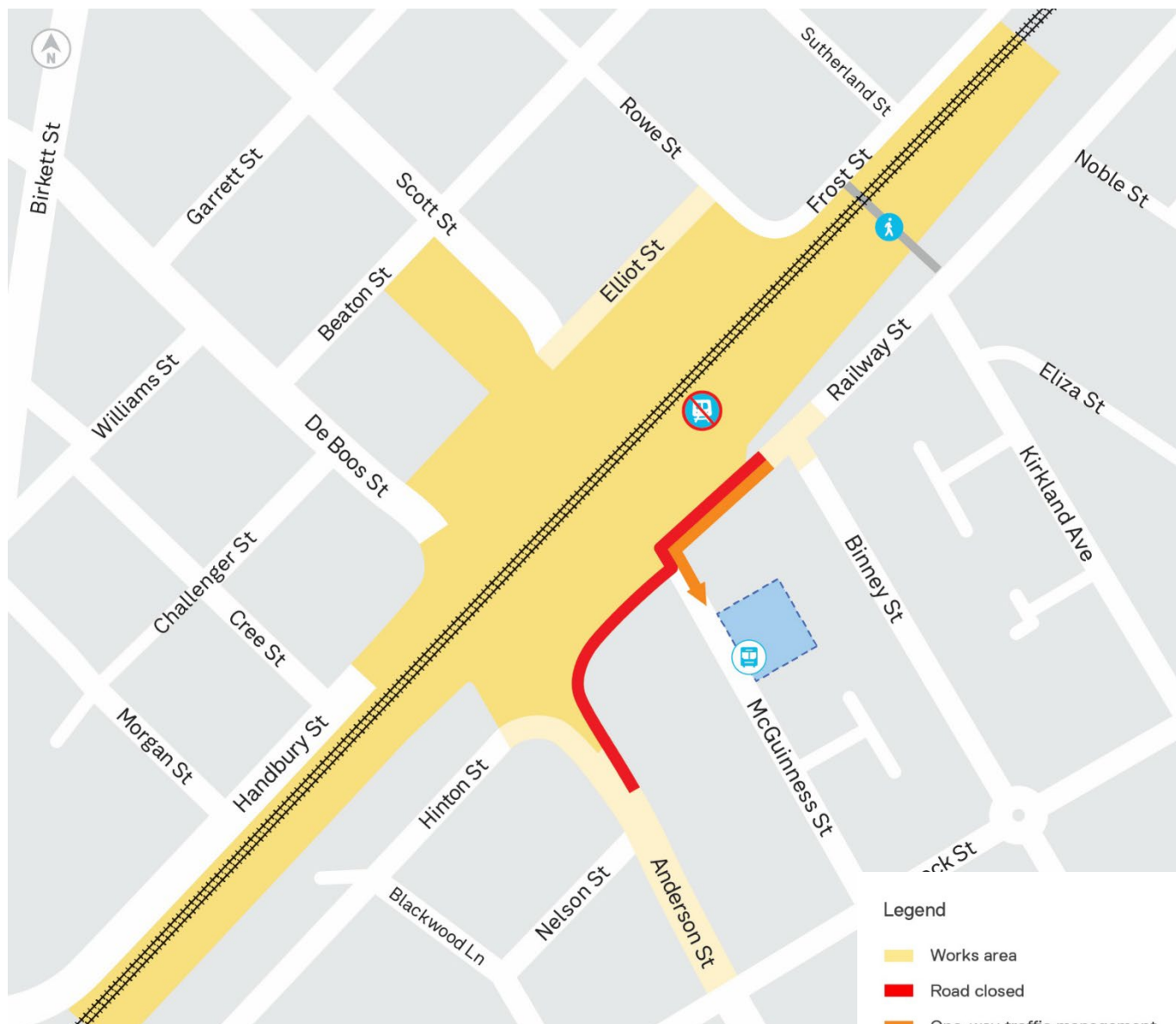
