

Level Crossing Works Narrabri to North Star 4 - 5 August 2026



Rhomberg Sersa Australia Pty Ltd (RSA) will be undertaking level crossing works on the Inland Rail alignment between **4 and 5 August 2026**.

Access across this level crossing will be maintained during the work.

The locations are:

Tuesday 4 August

1. Tarlee Road Crossing
2. Clump Road Crossing
3. Millie Road Crossing

Wednesday 5 August

1. Buckie Road Crossing
2. North Star Road Crossing

Work being done

RSA will be repairing asphalt near the rubber crossing panels on each side of the rail line.

Timings

Start date/time: Tuesday 28 July, 7am

End date/time: Wednesday 29 July, 5pm

RSA will be on site for two days, working between 7am and 5pm each day. Crews will work from south to north along the alignment starting at Tarlee Road level crossing and finishing at North Star Road level crossing.

What can I expect?

- Trucks and other vehicles entering and exiting the work site.
- Construction machinery and equipment operating on site adjacent to live traffic.
- Some minor traffic delays are expected during work hours.

How we're managing impacts

- The works at the level crossing will be undertaken in two halves so access across the level crossing can be always maintained.
- Traffic control will be in place and an alternating lane of traffic across the rail line will be maintained at all times.
- Lighting of the work site at night will be directed at the worksite and away from any nearby residents.

Cancellation of works

Works can sometimes be cancelled at short notice depending on weather and other factors. Should this occur, works will be rescheduled. Signage on site will advise of any changes.
