

Out of Hours Works

Junee LGA

3 August 2026

Our contractor Martinus is continuing construction works in Junee during the month of August. To support the safe delivery of steel girders and other associated construction materials, work outside of normal hours is subject to occur.

Delivery of bridge elements will occur **over the next few weeks** into the lead up of the next 96-hour track possession scheduled for the weekend of the 12 September 2026.

More information on the September possession will be communicated soon.

Kemp Street bridge

Monday 3 August from 6:00pm until 10:00pm.

- Expect to see deliveries of a 450-tonne crane, medium rigid truck and up to 10 B-Double trucks.
- All vehicles will be under escort
- Limited street parking will be available on Hill Street between Edgar Street and Ducker Street.
This street will remain under traffic control during this period.
- Crane setup will start on the corner of Hill and Edgar Street once delivered (estimated to take approximately 2 hours)
- Temporary fencing to be installed
- Pedestrian access to businesses on Hill Street will remain open

Regular Construction activities:

- At the completion of the out-of-hours activities noted above, additional delivery of bridge elements is scheduled to occur during regular construction hours on:
 - Monday 3 August until Wednesday 5 August
 - Monday 31 August until Wednesday 2 September
 - Monday 28 September until Thursday 1 October
- Should any additional out-of-hours works be required during these periods, key stakeholders will be notified in advance.

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicle movements will be to and from site, as well as on site.
- Traffic management will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed
- **Hill Street between Edgar and Ducker / Lorne will be under traffic control during deliveries and closed during each girder lift off the trucks and into the corridor.**

What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Heavy vehicle movements
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and materials
- An increase in deliveries of plant, equipment and materials to all our site compounds and ancillary facilities.

Equipment list

Hand tools, lighting towers, mobile cranes, truck and dogs, light, medium and heavy vehicles, vacuum trucks, watercarts.

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

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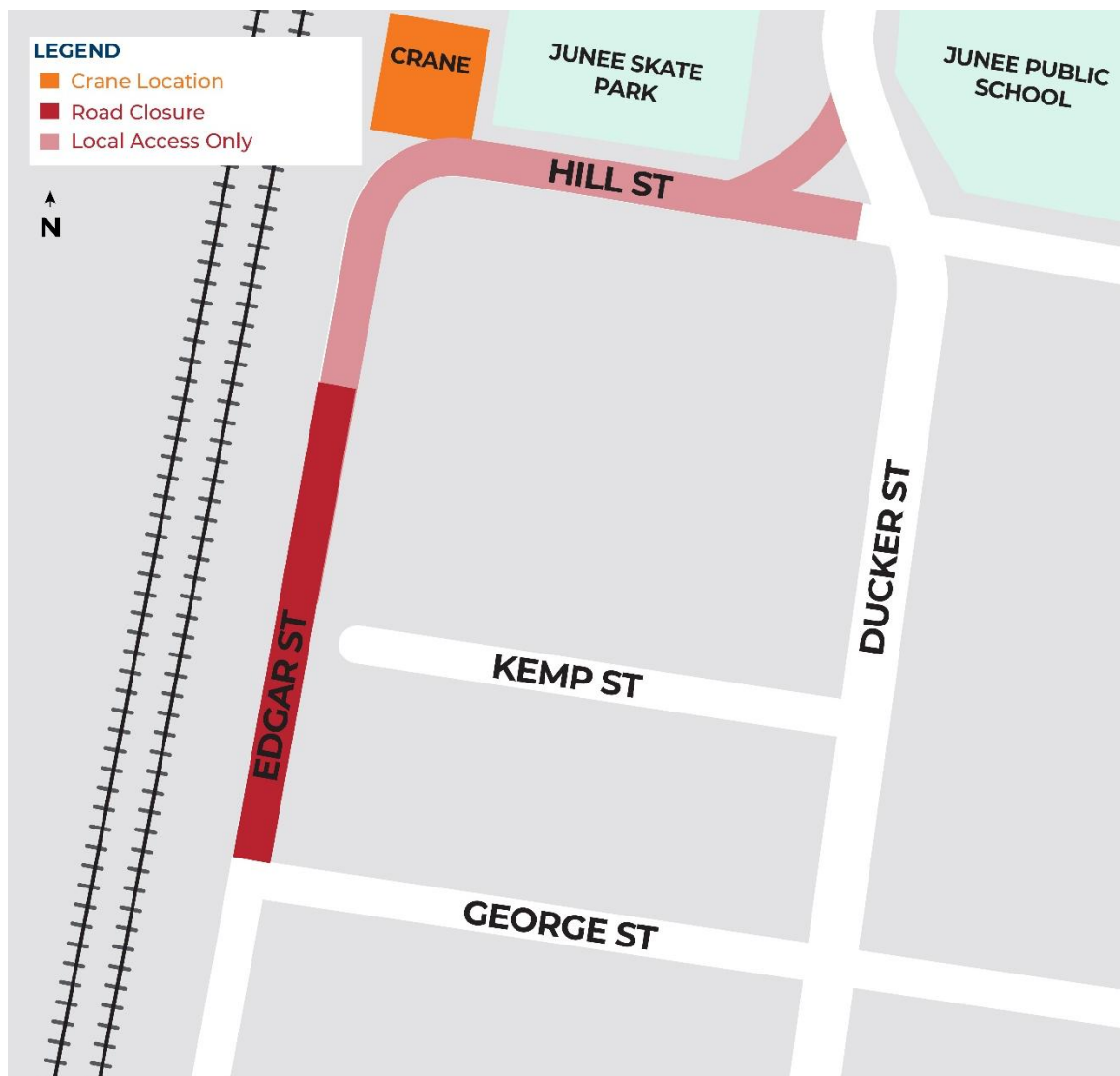


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Location of works:



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
